

Three years, many parishes, including our own, joined together into clusters. Our family of parishes will be joined by St. Joseph in Pierce. This will take place, according to the information we have at this point, in July of 2023.

As we move towards this new configuration, representatives from each of the parishes of Sacred Heart, St. Joseph, St. Leonard, St. Patrick and St. Peter will come up with a plan for our groupings of parishes.
