COVID 8 Mass begins this Sunday

We're starting a new Mass, temporarily, this Sunday. We're calling it the COVID-8. That's because it's at 8:00 AM and will continue to follow the strict COVID procedures that we have had at our Masses for the past year such as no singing, modified Communion procedures, no liturgical ministers etc. Our other weekend Masses will begin to open up over the next few weeks with congregational singing, song books back in the pews, Communion distributed during Mass, Communion distributed in lines, and liturgical ministers gradually added.

At this time the city of Minneapolis still has the mask mandate, even though it has been lifted by the state of Minnesota, so we will continue to require masks at all Masses. However, when the city lifts the mask mandate, masks will then be optional at our Masses, but the 8:00 AM Mass will still require masks.

This is an attempt to make people feel welcome, and comfortable coming to Mass. Many people are still at home because of their family's health situation. When the Archbishop rescinds the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, we want people, particularly those who have been staying at home, to know that there is a Mass option that maintains strict safety protocols at least for a while longer. It feels so good to be opening up! Praise God! This is something that we have been praying for, for a long time! Perfect weekend too since we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost today! Come Holy Spirit Come!

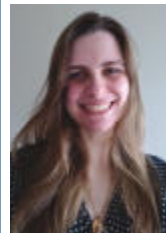

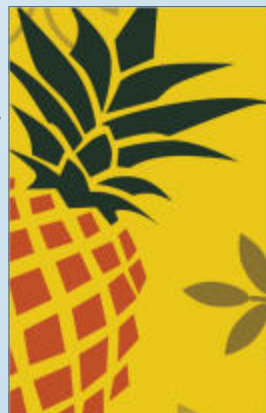
