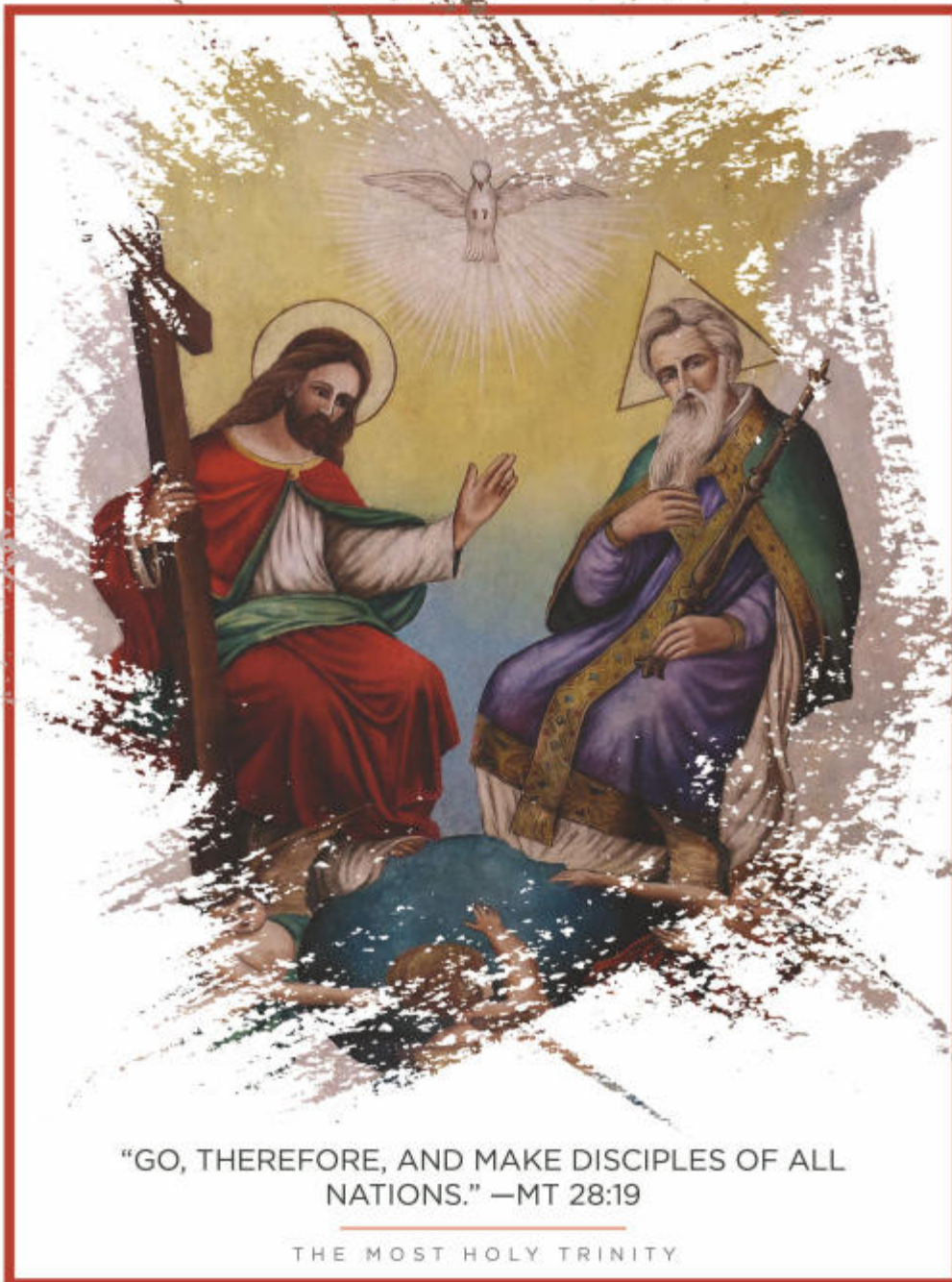

When Minneapolis lifts the mask mandate, these Masses will no longer require masks, but the special COVID AM Mass will continue with masks.

Bible study re-starts this Wednesday

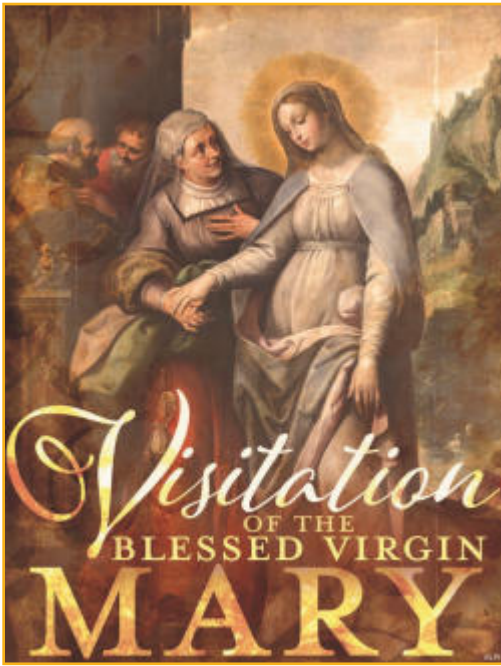

Pope Francis has called for a global prayer marathon for the entire month of May, praying for the end to the pandemic. Each day in May, there will be a livestream from one of 30 chosen Marian shrines or sanctuaries to guide the prayer at 6pm Rome time (noon EDT | 11am CDT) on all Vatican media platforms.

The pope opened the monthlong prayer May 1 and will conclude it May 31. Vatican: vatican.va

You will receive a weekly message with a link health care workers to pray for each week.

Pray for COVID-19 Anointing Corps, Patients, Families and Medical Support Teams: Parishioners across the Archdiocese are invited to prayerfully support those who are suffering most intensely, usually in sterile isolation, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Text archspm-anointing to 55321 or visit eva.us/archspm-anointing to receive a text each time a COVID-19 Anointing Corps Priest is dispatched to give the Last Rites. Upon receipt of the text, those in this ministry commit to take a moment to pray:

- One Our Father for the patient who is in danger of death, as they prepare to meet our Heavenly Father face-to-face;
- One Hail Mary for the patient's family and friends, asking the Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Sorrows, to intercede to comfort them; and
- One Glory Be in thanksgiving for the priest and for his protection, as well as the medical team attending to the patient.
