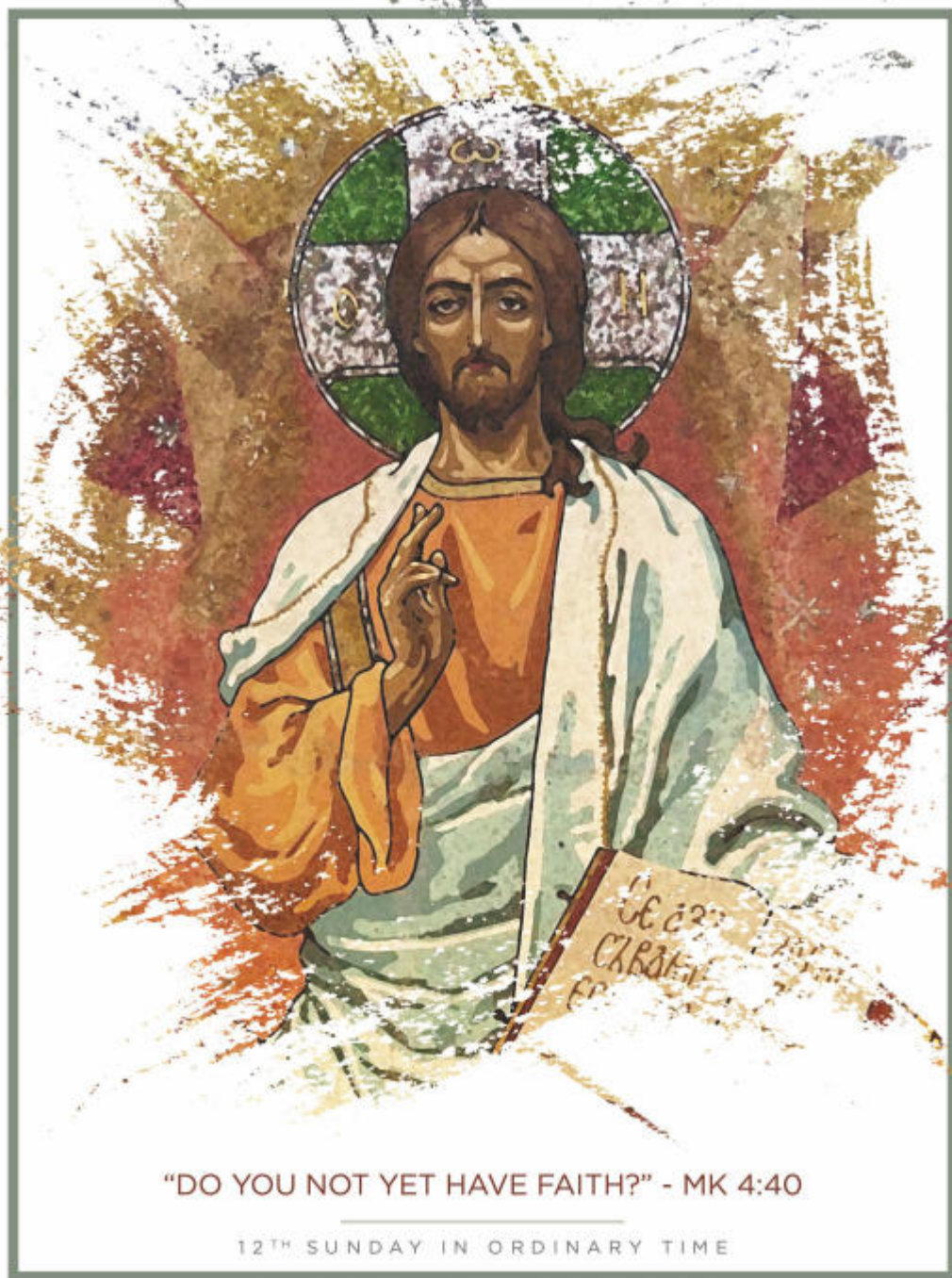

I will keep all of you in my prayers and I ask that you please keep me and all of our priests in your prayers. May the fruits of this gathering strengthen our local church!

**Sunday Obligation Dispensation being lifted on July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend**

Since March of 2020 the bishops of Minnesota have collectively dispensed the faithful in their dioceses from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. However, that is changing as of the Fourth of July weekend. Beginning then, once again, all Catholics in Minnesota are obligated to attend Sunday Mass. Of course, there are exceptions such as for those who are infirmed, or too elderly, lacking transportation, or needing to care for a sick person, etc. But for the vast majority of us, Baptized in Christ, we are obligated to celebrate the Eucharist faithfully on Sundays. The Sunday obligation can sound like a burden to some, but when you think about it, the Risen Christ is the most important reality in our lives. We need to celebrate and return to that reality each and every Sunday -the Lord's Day, not our own day. Nothing really is more important than celebrating the Eucharist on Sundays. Nothing rivals the celebration of the Eucharist. Let's all get back into the heart of our Faith, the Eucharist is the "Source and Summit" of our Faith, as proclaimed by Vatican II. We must do this for the good of our souls. It is like the air we breathe, or the water we drink. We cannot live without it! We need the Lord!

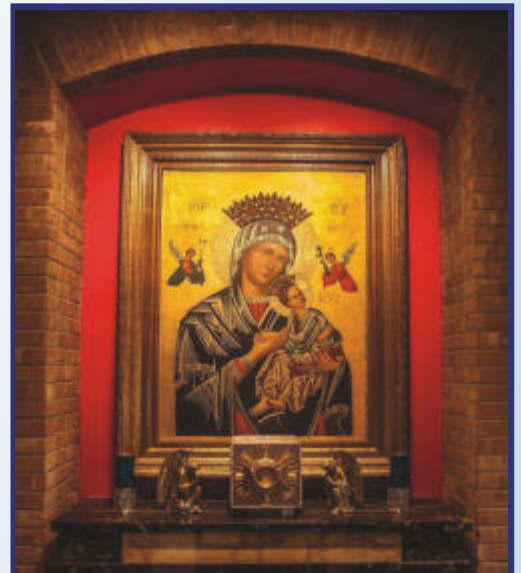
