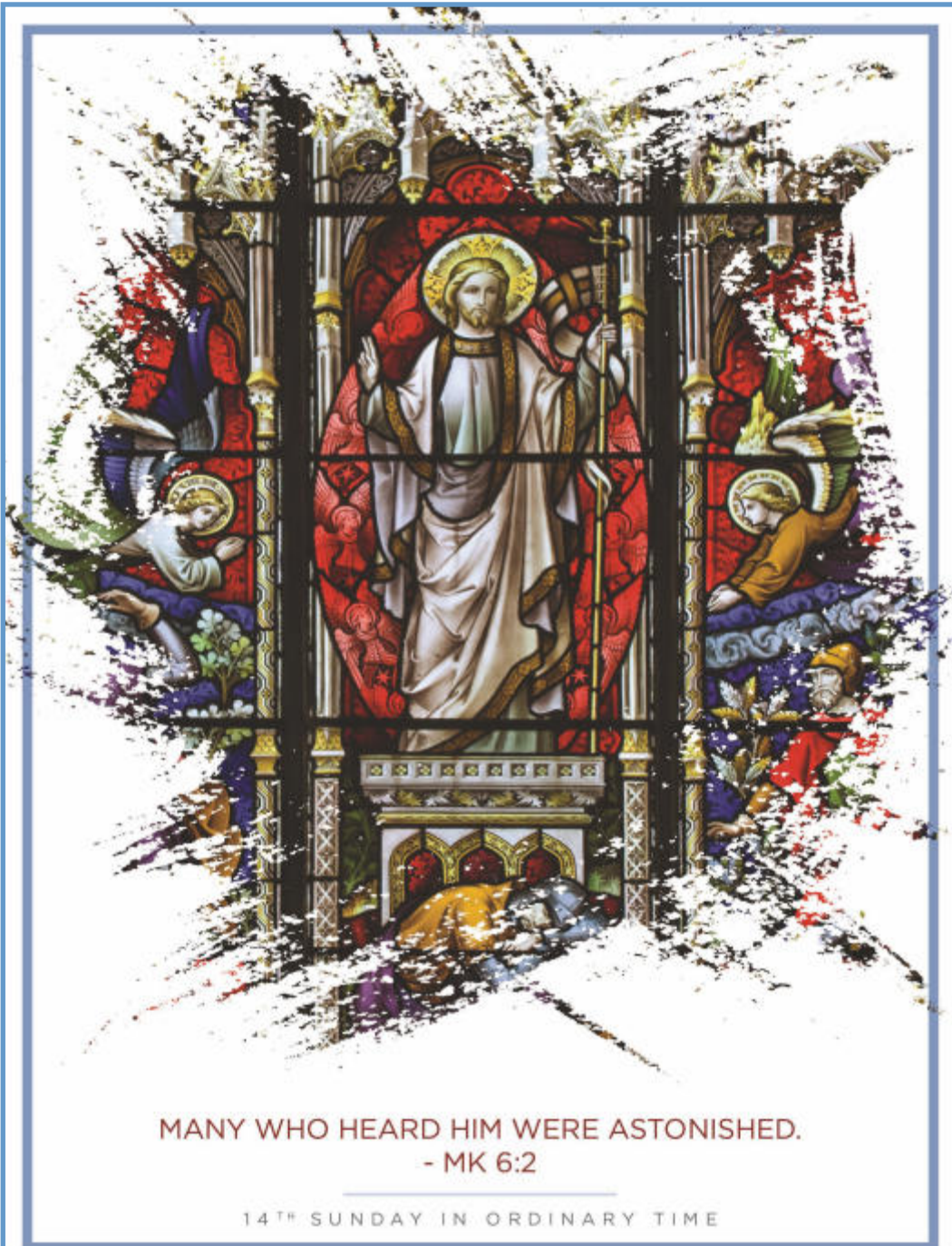

The Archbishop has removed the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass which means that attending Sunday Mass is once again a necessary part of living our Catholic Faith. Beginning this weekend, we will no longer livestream Sunday Mass. If you, or someone you know is unable to make it to Mass regularly, please contact Helen at the parish office so that we can arrange for someone to bring Holy Communion to you at your home. We continue with the our special **COVID Mass each Sunday at 8 AM**. At this Mass masks are required, there is no singing, social distancing is observed, no liturgical ministers are used, and special communion procedures are in place. If you or someone you know is hesitant to come back to Mass, please consider this option as you return to Mass. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life, we need to receive Jesus in the Eucharist every Sunday. Praise God that we are able to do this once again!

and a love that reaches out to all peoples as Jesus taught us.

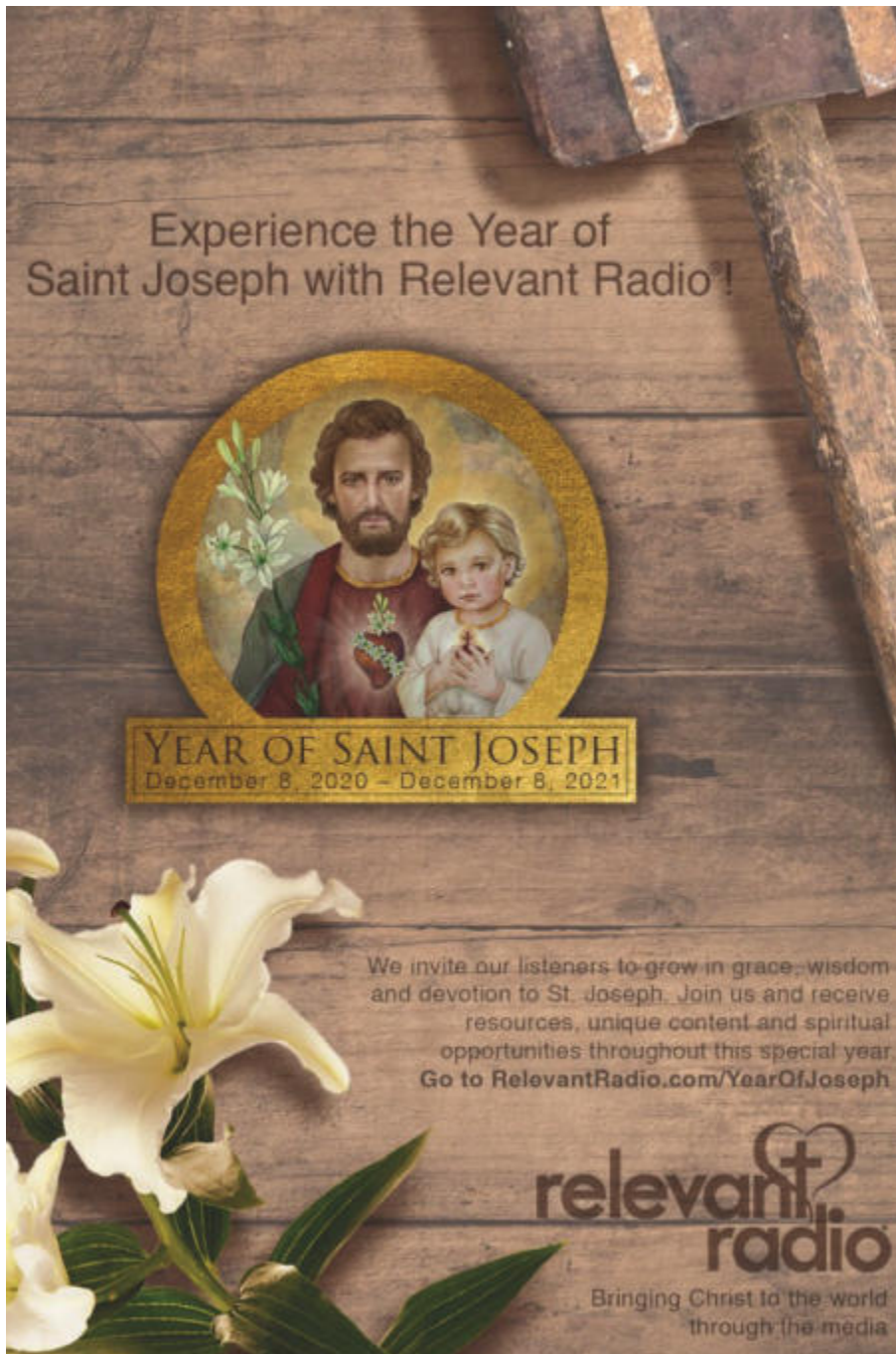

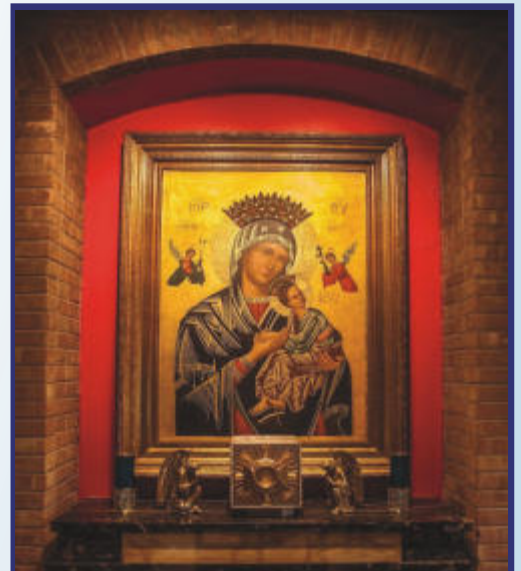
