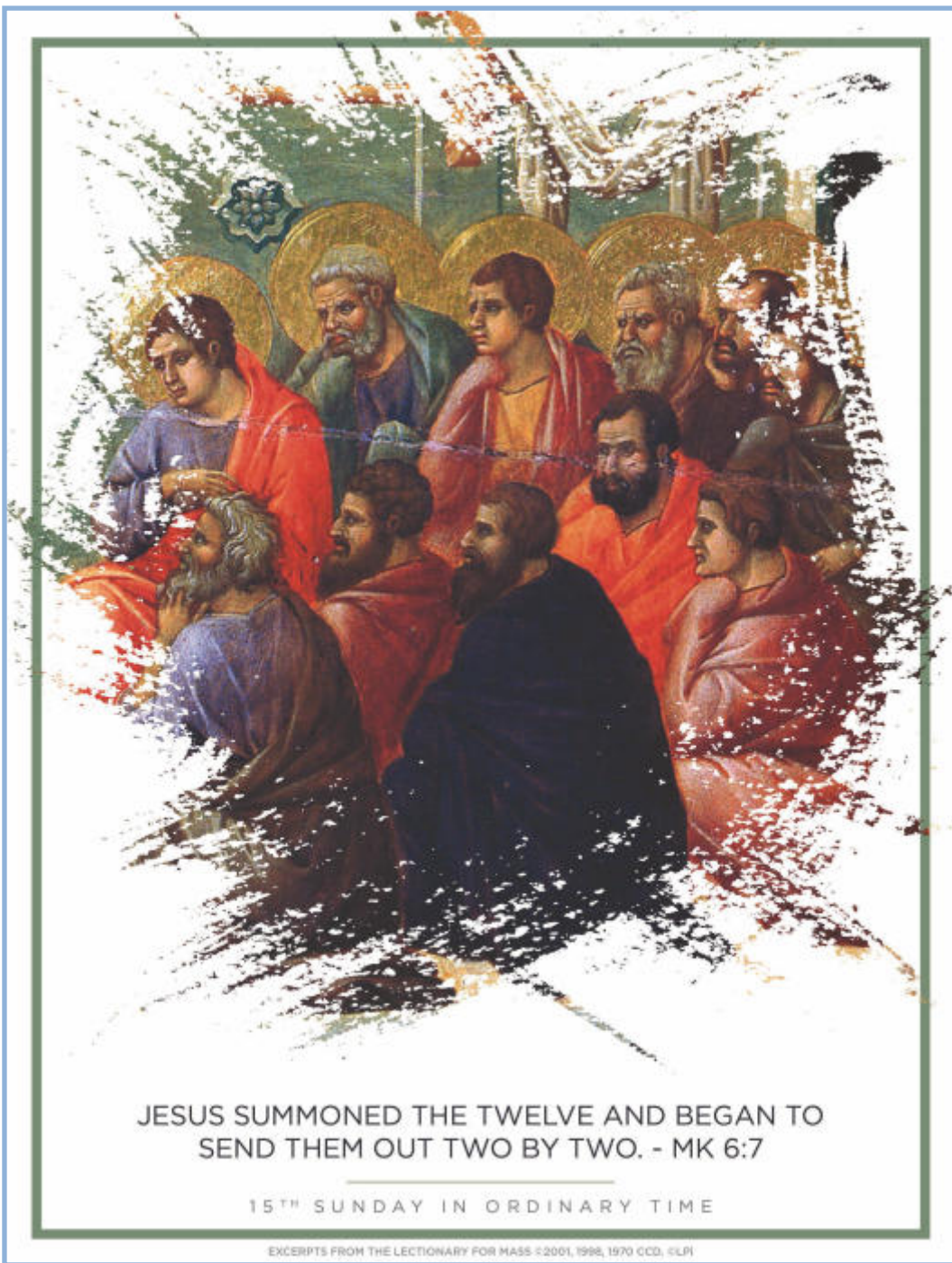

I thank everyone who worked so well on the annual school auction that was held on June 26<sup>th</sup>. It was a great time and a financial success! In the midst of COVID it was difficult to plan, not knowing months ago what would be possible, or not. Our leaders did a fantastic job, and other than a little rain that forced everything to be inside, the evening was wonderful! It was so nice for our school community to gather in ways that simply was not possible this past year. We don't have exact financial results tabulated yet, but the preliminary total income was around \$170,000 which is tremendous! Thank you to all who volunteered, and to all who came! We have a wonderful spirit of community here at Annunciation! God Bless you all!

**Visitation Tabernacle being restored**

A few weeks ago we sent the tabernacle from Visitation Church to a restoration company to be refurbished. For those who may not be familiar with our parish history, Annunciation and Visitation parishes merged in 2012. Visitation was located at Lyndale and 46<sup>th</sup> Street and is now Stonebridge Charter School. When the parishes merged the idea had been to incorporate the Visitation tabernacle into the Annunciation sanctuary as part of celebrating the merged identity of the two parishes. Our plan now is to refurbish the tabernacle, and appropriately place it directly behind the altar on a newly created structure that seamlessly blends with the sanctuary. Professional architect and parishioner Trace Jacques has been developing a beautiful design which seeks to integrate this structure with the midcentury look of our church. When the refurbished tabernacle is returned later this summer, we'll build a temporary structure to allow for parishioner feedback and thoughtful consideration of this endeavor. We want to ensure that sight lines, dimensions, spacing, steps, look, lighting, etc. are properly discerned before building the final structure with stone and wood to match the sanctuary space. The permanent structure will then be completed in a year or so as it will take time to order the specific finishing materials. Jesus is at the center of our parish life, and all that we do, and locating the tabernacle at the central focus point of the worship space emphasizes this reality.

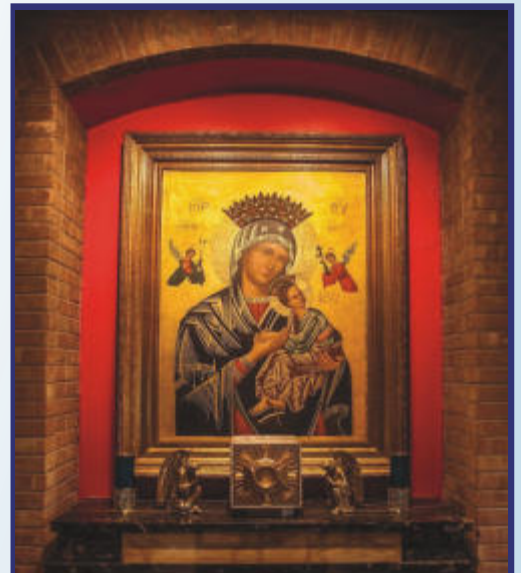
