Archdiocesan Synod, seeking 100 participants from Annunciation!

Now that we are moving past COVID, plans for the Archdiocesan synod are moving into full gear again. The Archbishop first announced the Synod in 2019 and listening sessions were held throughout the Archdiocese in the fall/winter of 2019-2020 before the pandemic shut everything down. The Synod itself will gather on the weekend of Pentecost, June 4 & 5, 2022 with two representatives from each parish participating.

In preparation, parishes throughout the archdiocese will hold small group meetings this September through November. There will be a series of six meetings over the course of this time with guidance materials provided by the Archdiocese. These gatherings will draw from groups already active at the parish such as the 12 Apostles, or Eucharistic adorers, liturgical ministers, choir members, youth ministry, Bible study groups etc. as well as others from the parish who simply want to participate. The Archbishop has asked that these small group meetings take the place of any other adult faith formation this fall.

Our parish goal is to have at least ten small groups with ten participants each for a total of 100 people from our parish engaged in this effort. This is a great way to help us to vibrantly emerge from the pandemic in our parish life. The work of these groups will help strengthen the ties among us as we get to know each other better and reflect upon the questions posed to us. It will be more than simply a practical exercise about the needs of the Archdiocese, but it will involve spiritual reflection as well.

Jimmy Dunn [email: jdunn@annunciationmsp.org] will coordinate the effort in our parish. To participate in these small groups, please contact the parish office. You will hear more about the synod in the weeks to come as we roll out the exact dates for these small group meetings. Please pray for the Synod and for those participating in this important endeavor. Archbishop Hebda has called this Synod with the hope of strengthening our Archdiocese in faith and love of Jesus. The strong participation of our parishioners is one way that we as a parish can strengthen the spiritual and pastoral life throughout our Archdiocese.
