




**GOSPEL: MK 1:7-11**

This is what John the Baptist proclaimed: "One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

On coming up out of the water he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon him. And a voice came from the heavens,

"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

**U.S. Bishops' Statement on Ethics of COVID-19 Vaccines:**

There are currently three vaccines that are likely to be made available in the coming months, those from Pfizer, Moderna, and AstraZeneca. Neither Pfizer nor Moderna used morally compromised cell lines in producing the vaccine. A confirmatory test, however, employing the commonly used, but morally compromised HEK293 cell line (from kidney cells taken from an aborted child in the Netherlands in 1972) was performed on both vaccines. Thus, while neither vaccine is completely free from any connection to morally compromised cell lines, in this case the connection is very remote from the initial evil of the abortion. The AstraZeneca vaccine is more morally compromised. The HEK293 cell line was used in the design, development, and production stages of that vaccine, as well as for confirmatory testing. Where possible, then, the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are to be used instead. Where that is not possible or would mean significant delay, the AstraZeneca vaccine may be used, in the same way that the Rubella vaccine is used because there is no alternative. **Sunday Communion Instructions:**

\*An Usher will excuse you from your pew. Please wait to stand or move toward the center aisle until the Usher signals to you.

\*The line will be single-file, and the Usher will release some pews on one side, then some pews from on the other side, and in that way alternate sides. Please follow the Usher's directions. **Please maintain 6 feet of distance between households while in line.**

\*Those sitting in the side pew sections will be ushered through the center section to join the Communion line.

\*At the front of the line will be a sign with instructions for dealing with your mask in order to receive communion, as well as a bottle of hand sanitizer:

- First remove your mask
- Then sanitize your hands
- Go to STAND on the farthest available X in front of the pew on your side of the church.
- Households of 2 people may stand together on an X. Larger households should divide so there are no more than 2 people on an X. Remember to leave adequate room between Xs.
- Receive Communion
- Replace your mask while still at the X.
- Return to your pew (more hand sanitizer is available in the front corners)

\*If you will not be receiving Communion today, please still come forward in line. When you get to the front of the line, move past the Xs to the side aisle to return to your pew.

\*At the X (for those receiving Communion), Father will move from communicant to communicant. He will be wearing a mask and will sanitize between communicants if he believes any contact was made.

\*You are encouraged to receive Communion on the hand, but you will not be refused Communion if you desire to receive on the tongue.

We realize this will take time, and we appreciate your patience. We are not in a rush, so please don't feel that you have to be, either.


**"LIFESAVER" WEEKEND -**


**Eau Claire Male Chorus 2020 Christmas Concert**
