I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.







JANUARY IS NATIONAL SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION MONTH: Human trafficking can be described as a form of modern slavery, where victims, either male or female are forced into commercial sex and/or labor. Victims come from any socioeconomic group, race, culture, religion, ethnic background or age. Nobody appears to be immune or safe. However, this is an issue that many Americans are unaware of. Every day, people are coerced, deceived and forced into being trafficked, even by those close to them. Human trafficking and exploitation thrive on secrecy, and can only be ended through awareness. There are 25 different types of trafficking within the United States. Examples are: Sex trafficking, forced labor, forced marriage, exploitative begging and pornography. Many are targeted online. They are groomed and coerced.

If you think you have info about a trafficking situation, report immediately. Anti-trafficking Hotline Advocates are available 24/7 to take a report at 888-373-7888.

**Ushers** (4-5 per Mass): Greet those who come to celebrate Mass with us and be a welcoming face of the Parish. **What's Involved:** Welcome people at the doors & give them a Bulletin/Liturgy Guide, take up the Collection, & assist with Communion. **Time Commitment:** Arrive 30 minutes before the start of Mass, & done 15 minutes after. **Who:** No maximum age! Teens can help, too – confirmation prep & up.

**Readers** (1 per Mass): Proclaim the Word of God at Mass. **What's Involved:** Carry the Book of the Gospels in the Entrance Procession, proclaim the First & Second Readings, & lead the Prayer of the Faithful. **Time Commitment:** Arrive 20 minutes before the start of Mass. **Who:** Teens (confirmation prep & up) or adults.

**Sacristans** (1 per Mass): Assist with Mass preparations & cleaning up afterward. **What's Involved:** Prepare the Altar & sacred vessels, light the candles, turn on lights before Mass, & undo them after. **Time Commitment:** Arrive 30-45 minutes before the start of Mass, & stay 15 minutes after. **Who:** Teens (confirmation prep) or adults.

**Sanitizers** (2 per Mass): Clean the high-touch areas of church after Mass. **What's Involved:** Use the sanitizing solution to wipe down door handles, railings, & bathrooms. **Time Commitment:** 10-15 minutes after Mass. **Who:** Teens or adults.

*Remember, we require all Parish volunteers wear a mask because they are regularly in close contact with others.*


