

#### **Baptisms**

You must be a registered parishioner and attend a baptism class. This class is held the second Wednesday of every month. A registration form can be found on the website or in the kiosk at church. **The form MUST be completed and turned in the Monday before the Baptism class.** If not turned in by this deadline, you will need to attend the class the following month.

#### **Marriage**

According to the Archdiocesan guidelines and to ensure adequate preparation for this very important Sacrament, **you must make arrangements at least six (6) months ahead of the Marriage date.** Please complete the registration form found on our website. Special instructions are required for any Catholic party under 19 years of age. No date can be set for this marriage. A Civil Marriage License should be obtained two weeks in advance of marriage. **To set a wedding date here at St. Gerald Catholic Church, you must be a registered parishioner.**

#### **Family Formation: K-8**

Children of the parish are supplied with Family Formation either in our 5-day school or in our Family Formation Program. Regular and sustained Family Formation is a life-long process. Parental support at home for their children's religious formation includes attendance at the Sunday Eucharist, prayer at home, and support of the catechetical program of their choice. Parishioners who homeschool are encouraged to visit with the Family Formation Director about their children's preparations for the sacraments.





Happy Fall! Along with the changing colors of the trees and fields, have you noticed some garden flags popping up at our parish and school? Since October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, these flags illustrate various titles of Our Blessed Mother Mary and her role as the mother of Jesus and us, the church.

Did you know that Saint John Paul II and Saint Mother Teresa refer to the rosary as a weapon against evil?


Below is a description on 2 of the garden flags that are on display.

### Madonna and Child with Bird

This painting is from Peru. The painter is unknown. It has strong native Incan iconography. Birds were considered sacred, partially because of their ability to fly. Thus, birds or bird feathers were included in images of Jesus and Mary to indicate their sacred and honored positions.

### Mary, Undoer of Knots

In this painting the Blessed Virgin Mary stands on the crescent moon (the usual way of depicting Mary under her title of the Immaculate Conception). She is surrounded by angels. The Holy Spirit in the form of a dove hovers above her. Mary unties knots from a long ribbon and at the same time rests her foot on the head of a "knotted" snake. The serpent represents the devil, and her treatment of him fulfills the prophecy in Genesis 3:15: "I will put enmities between thee and the woman, and thy seed and her seed: she shall crush thy head, and thou shalt lie in wait for her heel."
