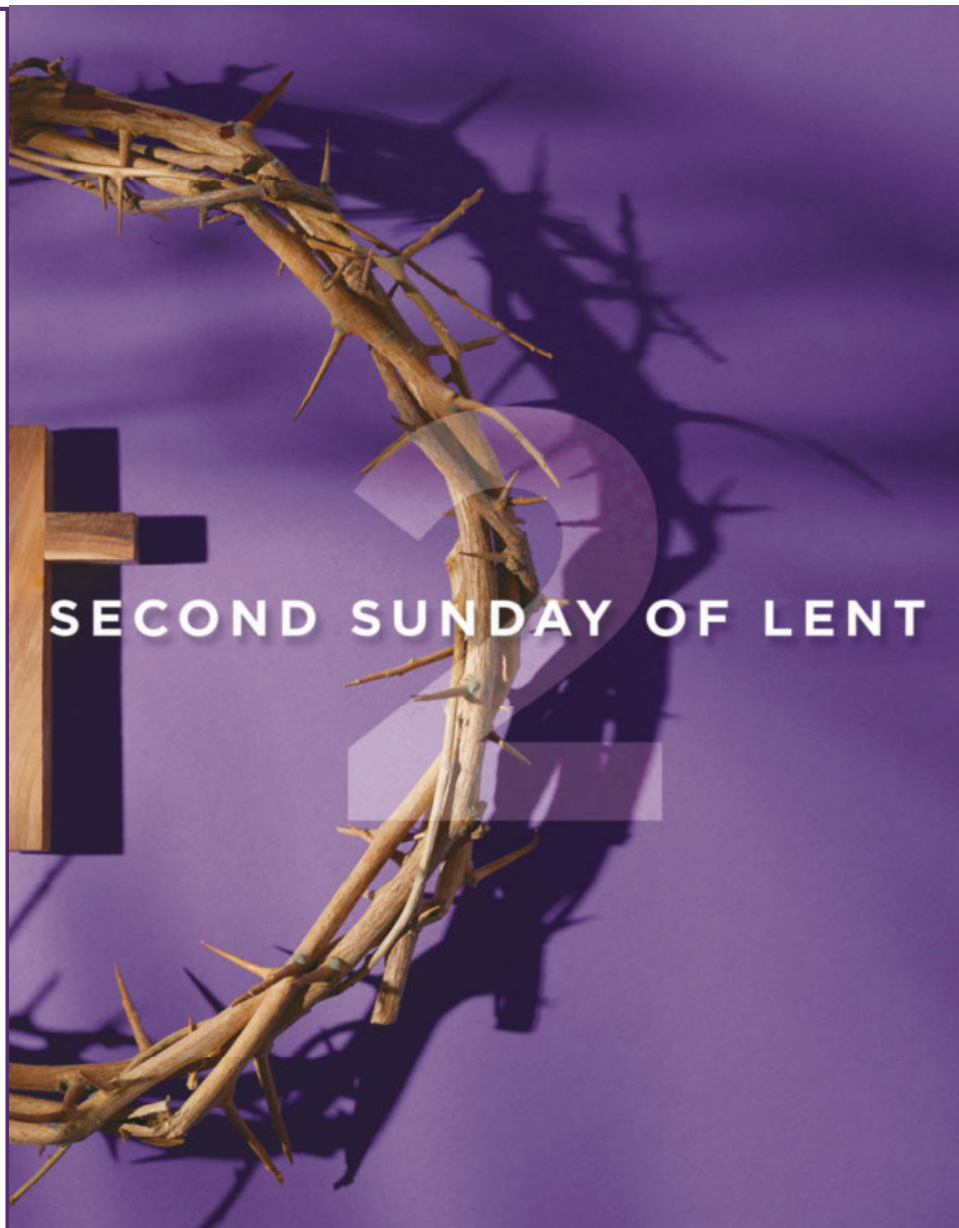

Baptisms

You must be a registered parishioner and attend a baptism class. This class is held the second Wednesday of every month. A registration form can be found on the website or in the kiosk at church. **The form MUST be completed and turned in the Monday before the Baptism class.** If not turned in by this deadline, you will need to attend the class the following month.

Marriage

According to the Archdiocesan guidelines and to ensure adequate preparation for this very important Sacrament, **you must make arrangements at least six (6) months ahead of the Marriage date.** Please complete the registration form found on our website. Special instructions are required for any Catholic party under 19 years of age. No date can be set for this marriage. A Civil Marriage License should be obtained two weeks in advance of marriage. **To set a wedding date here at St. Gerald Catholic Church, you must be a registered parishioner.**

Family Formation: K-8

Children of the parish are supplied with Family Formation either in our 5-day school or in our Family Formation Program. Regular and sustained Family Formation is a life-long process. Parental support at home for their children's religious formation includes attendance at the Sunday Eucharist, prayer at home, and support of the catechetical program of their choice. Parishioners who homeschool are encouraged to visit with the Family Formation Director about their children's preparations for the sacraments.

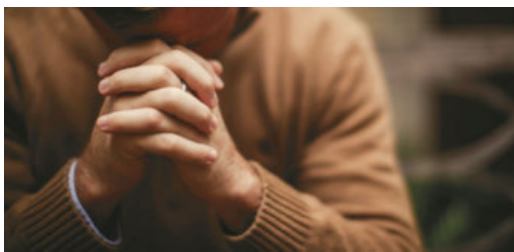

Live Lent with your Family!

Here are some simple ways to encourage your family in their relationship with God this Lent.

Prayer:

Once a week **read the Sunday Gospel together.** Teach your children to notice what "sticks out" to them in the reading and talk about what God could be saying to them in His Word.

Prayer through song:

Commit to **listening to Christian radio** in your car and let your kids learn how to pray through praise music.

Adoration:

Go to adoration as a family during Lent. Even if it's for 10 minutes, let your children experience the quiet prayer before Jesus. Bring journals for them to draw or write to Jesus. **Or come to Oasis or Ablaze together** (even if you stay for only a little while) your children will receive graces before Jesus.

Do a family devotional during a meal. Turn off all electronics and give a few minutes to intentional prayer and using a resource of your choice.

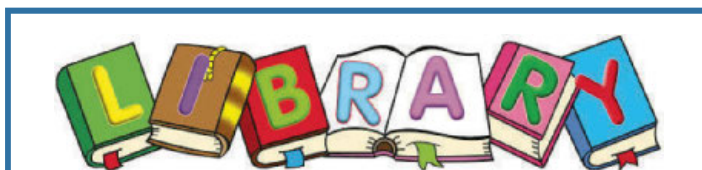

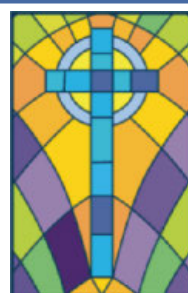

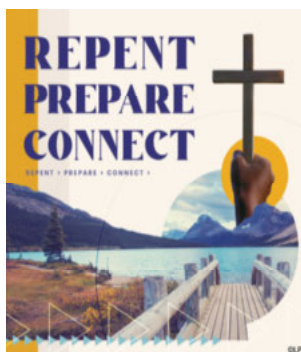
