



Bantisms

You must be a registered parishioner and attend a baptism class. This class is held the second Wednesday of every month. A registration form can be found on the website or in the kiosk at church. The form MUST be completed and turned in the Monday before the Baptism class.

Marriage

According to the Archdiocesan guidelines and to ensure adequate preparation for this very important Sacrament, you must make arrangements at least six (6) months ahead of the Marriage date. Please complete the registration form found on our website. Special instructions are required for any Catholic party under 19 years of age. No date can be set for this marriage. A Civil Marriage License should be obtained two weeks in advance of marriage. To set a wedding date here at St. Gerald Catholic Church, you must be a registered parishioner.

Family Formation: K-8

Children of the parish are supplied with Family Formation either in our 5-day school or in our Family Formation Program. Regular and sustained Family Formation is a life-long process. Parental support at home for their children's religious formation includes attendance at the Sunday Eucharist, prayer at home, and support of the catechetical program of their choice. Parishioners who homeschool are encouraged to visit with the Family Formation Director about their children's preparations for the sacraments.

A memorial book to write the names of your loved ones is located under the memorial crosses in the back of church at 96th & Q, and at Lakeview, it is located at the front of the church, by Mary.



Our Lady of Fatima wants to come into your heart and home!

Most people are unable to make a pilgrimage to Fatima, Portugal, the place where Mary appeared to three children and asked them to pray the rosary for peace and the conversion of Russia. So instead, the statue of the Our Lady of Fatima can come to your home. This devotion involves the statue residing in different homes on a weekly basis. It is recommended that the person/family recite the Rosary (or even just a decade) daily to honor Mary and ask for her intercession. Generally, the statue is

transported to and from homes, on Saturdays. This devotion is offered for world peace, conversion of sinners, and vocations to the priesthood and religious life. 

for the souls entrusted to them.




