## TRANSFIGURATION

Dear Friends,

Our Parish Festival is only 2 weeks away. Please mark your calendars and plan to be present for a wonderful day of family fun and good old-fashioned celebration. In addition, remember to pick up your raffle tickets at the festival booth under the outside awning after Mass. You may also purchase tickets through our front desk, Monday-Friday.



As I mentioned last Sunday at the 8:30 a.m. Mass, Pope Francis' recent decision to restrict the celebration and promulgation of the Traditional Latin Mass saddened me. While I certainly agree with many of the Pope's concerns regarding traditionalist circles and certain schismatic attitudes that are at times found within them, I am nevertheless deeply concerned that the Pope has chosen a method of addressing these problems that may very well exacerbate them. If ever there was a time for accompaniment, I think it is now. But... I am not the Pope (and you are very lucky because of it!!!), and the Holy Father is well within his right to issue these newest liturgical regulations. Whatever your opinions are of them, I beg of you to pray for our Holy Father and for the unity of the Church, a unity founded on faith, hope and charity. In reflecting with some friends who share my sorrow and disappointment with the Pope's decision, I was reminded of the beautiful prayer of Saint John Henry Newman, the great English convert of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Its words remind us to remain confident and full of hope, even when we are disappointed or frustrated with the circumstances of life.

*God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught.*

## Extreme Faith Camp Recap

Recently 17 middle school students along with 3 high school students spent a week at Trout Lake Camps in Pine River, MN for Extreme Faith Camp (EFC). This year EFC teamed up with Catholic Youth Summer Camp (CYSC) to offer the students a fun-filled week of faith and activities. During camp, the campers got the opportunity to attend the Holy Mass daily, adore Christ in The Most Blessed Sacrament, and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Campers also enjoyed a wide variety of rec activities, like high ropes, banana boats, a water obstacle course, laser tag, archery, and zip lining.



On Wednesday night, during adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the priest processed by each camper, blessing them, and allowing them to have a closer encounter with Jesus. The following night campers in their small groups took turns asking for prayers and allowing the rest of their group to pray over them. Both of these were powerful and hopefully lasting experiences for the campers.

Additionally, this year the campers were challenged to practice the Lectio Divina prayer they learned with a different Bible verse each day for a year. All campers who complete this challenge will be rewarded with a bowling and pizza party! Please continue to pray for these youth, that they may keep the same excitement about our Lord at home that they had at camp.

Here is testimony from one of the campers:

“I came to EFC not wanting to be vulnerable with God, with others, and not with myself. I built walls around my heart to avoid being vulnerable; but the first night Jesus looked me in the eyes, knocked down my walls and said ‘I want all of you.’ Over the week He helped me to give me Him just that.” (Frankie C.)

We praise God for His gracious gift of life and ask for the intercession of His Mother in answering the prayers of those who await the gift of a child!


## Bible in a Year Series
