## TRANSFIGURATION



Dear Friends,

This past Friday, Holy Mother Church celebrated the Feast Day of St. Therese of Lisieux, a French nun who died at the age of 24 in the year 1873. Also known as “The Little Flower,” Therese is beloved by millions of Catholics around the world, mostly because of her important “little way” described in her spiritual autobiography, “The Story of a Soul.” In short, the little way is the way of small acts

done with great love. Many of us may not be in circumstances or situations where obvious acts of great sacrifice or charity are readily available or warranted. But we nevertheless can always choose the way of love, acting out of devotion to God and exercising selfless love of neighbor, even in the littlest of things. And this little way, which is the way of spiritual childhood and built upon a humble awareness of both our own littleness and the greatness of God, is the way to heaven.

But while many know of St. Therese and her famous autobiography, much fewer know that she is a patroness of the missions. This patronage is not terribly intuitive. Therese spent the majority of her very short life within a small part of late 19<sup>th</sup> century France; no great trips around the world, no journeys to the Americas, no long voyages to plant the flag of Christendom upon the Eastern shores. And yet she had within her saintly heart a burning desire to be missionary, and to be bold in the proclamation of the Faith to believer and non-believer alike. But the Lord had other plans for her. Her Carmelite monastery was the ship from which she set sail across the seas, carried by her fervent prayers and sacrifices offered up for the success of the missions. Her statue’s presence in the Cathedral of Saint Paul’s “Shrine of Nations” is a reminder of her intercessory role in the missionary efforts of the Church even today.

Because we exist as a parish to **reach out** to our neighbors and to bring them to Christ! We do not exist for ourselves! We must be evangelical and we must be bold if we are to flourish as a parish. More importantly, we must be evangelical and we must be bold if we are to be pleasing to God.

It is my hope and my prayer that the Little Flower may intercede for our parish and secure for it all the graces we need to be real missionary disciples, willing to leave our comfort zone and to invite all into a transfiguring relationship with Jesus Christ, the Source and Summit of our daily and eternal lives.






