Dear Friends,

We're back to Ordinary Time, though we will continue to keep up the creche until Candlemas on February 2, in keeping with long standing custom. Let us keep our eyes fixed upon the Little Child in these weeks ahead, even as our life returns to "normal" as the holiday season fades.

Lots of going on these days, and lots of important updates to give. Here we go...

1. I'm a bit behind on my thank you notes, as usual, but please know of my deep gratitude to all who gave gifts and Christmas wishes these past few weeks to Father Lynch, to me and to our hard-working staff. Your love for this parish and for me is a great gift, and I am continuously humbled by your care and generosity. If you haven't yet gotten your thank you card, keep looking in your mailbox! It's from the heart and written with great love and thankfulness.
2. Our Sunday plate income continues to be lower than budgeted, and I would encourage you to continue to prayerfully discern what you give to the parish in gratitude to God and to this community. I am grateful to Erin Ethier, my parish trustees and finance council for their wise counsel on how we can best address the deficit between our operating costs and our income. Like all of you, this discrepancy forces difficult choices and I ask you for prayers of wisdom and strength so as to best manage and use the resources with which we have been entrusted. As you might imagine, snow plowing bills this year will be quite high. Help if you can by considering increasing your monthly donation.
3. While our income and operating costs are a real challenge right now, I do have some profoundly good news on the financial front. Thanks to the generosity and sacrifices of so many, our current debt is below 2 million! This represents remarkable progress and is cause for great rejoicing and gratitude to God. Erin Ethier kindly provides the report.

In October 2021, Transfiguration launched a capital campaign to reduce our parish debt of just over \$3.9 million. The campaign raised over \$2.75 million in pledges, which exceeded the pledge goal of \$2.5 million.

As of January 9th, just 15 months after the campaign began, we have successfully collected and paid off almost \$2 million of long-term debt and the balance is now under \$2 million! (The balance as of January 9, 2023, was \$1,976,956.) Thank you to all of the generous donors that have given sacrificially to this effort and are bringing Transfiguration closer to a debt-free future!

- School enrollment is open. Please spread the word about our tremendous school and do encourage your family and friends to attend our upcoming events and open house. We recently completed a "Catholic Schools Study," an evaluation conducted by the Archdiocesan School's Office which is meant to assist schools in growing in excellence and vitality. While the formal report has not been released yet, I was thrilled to hear from the visitors who conducted the study that they were deeply impressed by our faculty, particularly their love for the Catholic Faith and their desire to share it with their students. What is more, at least one visitor mentioned that our school was perhaps the most beautiful Catholic School they have been in, thanks to the magnificent art we added a few years ago and the sacramental life available to our kids. Thanks be to God!
- This past week we interviewed 3 highly qualified candidates for our permanent principal position, including Sue Berthiaume, our current interim principal. We should be able to announce very shortly our hire.
- Finally, I promise you finally... After many years of serving Transfiguration faithfully as our Director of Parish Formation, Justin Kortuem has discerned that it is time to seek opportunities elsewhere. Justin will finish out this present Faith Formation season, which concludes at the end of April. I have asked Father Brian Lynch to assume Justin's duties in regard to directing our faith formation program, with the assistance of Melissa Phinney. Father will begin these duties as soon as Justin's time with us concludes. We are still figuring out who will handle the many other events and tasks that have been Justin's responsibilities.

Justin has been a great gift to me and to this parish during my time as pastor, and I know that he has deeply impacted the lives of many here, particularly the men with whom he has met Saturday after Saturday and rubbed elbows with at Wednesday night basketball. His love for the Lord and the demands of discipleship have been a compelling witness to me and I am grateful. We will find a way to honor our brother for his years of service in the months ahead.

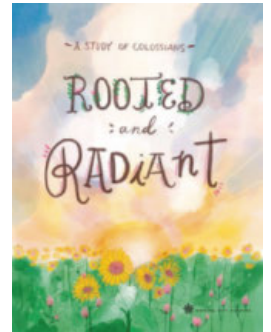

Donut Sunday Volunteers Needed



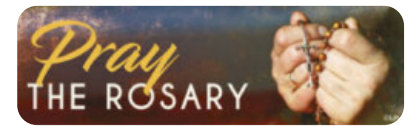
