## TRANSFIGURATION



*The children of the Hebrews, carrying olive branches, went to meet the LORD, crying out and saying: Hosanna in the highest!*

With the start of Palm Sunday Mass, Holy Mother Church enters her most important time of the year. For during this week we remember and make present, albeit sacramentally, the fundamental mysteries of our salvation. While Christmas has the advantage of the trappings of a secular holiday – school breaks, parties of all sorts, time away from work in festivity and merrymaking – the objective fact is that Holy Week, and the Triduum in particular, has pride of place among all liturgical celebrations. It is an easy fact to forget, if one were to evaluate its worth solely on economic power at Hallmark, Target, and Walmart (Christmas stuff goes on sale, what, the day after Halloween?), and kids are right back at school a few days after Easter Sunday. And yet no other week can claim the importance of Holy Week. Indeed, its name says it all.

My childhood pastor once remarked that Christmas is for children while Easter is for adults. His rationale was that while Christmas, both the religious and secular commemoration, is full of images of warmth, innocence and sentimentality, Easter joy demands that one has experienced death of some sort, as well as some knowledge of one’s need for a messiah. I think this is very true. Christmas also has the added advantage of being a time of gift giving, which of course adds to its appeal to children. And yet if one looks closer, I wonder if the opposite might not also be true. Christmas is a season of profound hope, which the adult Christian, worn down by struggle, failures, and ordinary life, needs more than perhaps the child. The Infant King comes to save the barren, the forgotten, the lowly ones.

If one meditates upon the shepherds at Bethlehem as historical figures, dirty and tired, rather than as figurines in a Fontanini crèche, perhaps one can see oneself invited to adore the Little God. And as for Holy Week, it is precisely the faith of a child that unlocks the awesome power of its liturgies. A God who rides on a donkey. A God who becomes bread. A God who bleeds. A God who lays alone in the darkness of the tomb and offers peace to those who betrayed Him with an outstretched hand and wounded side. Without the acceptance of a little heart, full of wonder and awe at what God alone can do, this week of weeks quickly loses its power, and can become consumed by last minute Easter Brunch plans and even the dread of family commitments.

And so may the cries of the children in this weekend's opening procession become our own. May their faith, the faith of little ones, open our eyes to what God is doing this week, and what He still wants to do in our own life and parish. May we see beyond the itinerant preacher riding on an ass, and find the God who comes to look for us, afraid and alone like a lost lamb. May we look beyond the celebrant as he kneels to wash feet, and see the True and Living God who genuflects to the sinner so that he might be saved. May we look beyond the cross we venerate on Good Friday and see the love of a God who to ransom a slave, sold his Son. May we look beyond the glow of the Easter Fire and see the raging compassion of the God who is eager to burn up all that is not good and holy within us so that we might shine. And may we look past the splendid physical beauty of Easter Sunday's sanctuary and see our own destiny in heaven.

Please do invite your family and friends to join you for this week's celebrations, especially if they have been away from church or Transfiguration for a long time. We want our church full for Easter Sunday, full of the hearts of children who will cry out with joy to the God who saves them. And please also consider giving a little bit extra this Easter. We continue to be slightly below our projected income for this year, and we need help to cover our operating costs. Thank you for your consideration and sacrificial generosity!

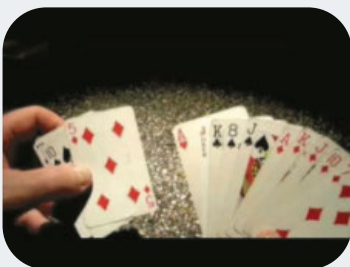

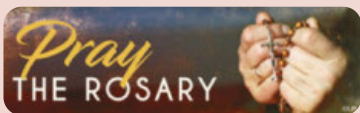
## Black and Gold Gala/Reunion

# FINANCIAL UPDATE FROM ERIN ETHIER





We recently received a copy of the annual Archdiocesan School Report (ASR) and Vitality Index from Catholic Finance Corporation (CFC). The annual ASR report includes an analysis of key financial levers, called the Financial Vitality Index, that assists leadership in identifying financial realities that require further examination.



One area of opportunity for Transfiguration is a key financial lever labeled “Other Funding Sources”. This lever includes fundraising, donations and funding from outside sources. For the 2021-2022 school year **Transfiguration reported \$98,128** in “Other Funding” as compared to the **Archdiocesan-wide average of \$380,551** and the **average for schools of Transfiguration’s size of \$328,759**. As you can see, we have a significant gap in other funding sources as compared to other schools with similar enrollment within our Archdiocese.

Why is this important? The method of funding Catholic Schools has changed significantly over the past several decades with outside funding becoming necessary. Transfiguration is still relying mainly on parishioners and school parents as the source of revenue and has not fostered significant relationships with outside organizations and individuals. This model is not sustainable and is placing significant and unsustainable financial pressure on the parish.

How can you help? Do you know of alumni students and families that aren’t connected to Transfiguration? Are you aware of organizations or individuals within our community that will support Catholic education? We need your help making connections and fostering relationships that will bring outside funding to our school.
