## TRANSFIGURATION



Not quite a month ago, during my homily at Mass, I mentioned that we will be focusing as a parish on growing our school's enrollment by specifically concentrating our efforts on preschool and kindergarten. I mentioned that the goal is for us to increase our enrollment by ten students in both preschool and kindergarten as a way of not only increasing tuition for the school's financial health, but more importantly in drawing more families into the environment of Catholic education and building the community of Transfiguration not just as a school, but as a parish. Sometimes it is easy for us to think of the school and the parish as separate corporations or independent organizations, but the fact is that Transfiguration is a Catholic parish that has a school as its largest ministry. As a ministry of the parish, the school offers us the greatest potential to evangelize children and by extension their parents.

As a way of helping to draw all of us into the work of building our school's enrollment, I am inviting everyone in our parish to join us for a town hall to discuss the vision for our school and ways in which we can all help recruit more students into preschool and kindergarten beginning this year. We will have two options for people to attend our school town hall: one will be this Wednesday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. and the other Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Both town halls will take place in the Gathering Space and my hope is that more than just current or prospective school families will attend, because each of us has a stake in the school's success. The town halls will have an opportunity for people to share their ideas on how to draw families into our school as well as providing materials and talking points that people can use to help encourage family, friends, neighbors, or even strangers to come and be a part of the great work taking place here at Transfiguration.

## PASTOR'S COLUMN (continued from page 1)

The reason why we are choosing to focus our efforts on building preschool and kindergarten is because if these numbers increase, it will create a pipeline that carries through to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Every Catholic school inevitably experiences some level of attrition as families move to a different city, adjust their educational plans, or can no longer afford tuition despite efforts to help with financial aid. Thus, in planning for the future, a school will always want to have a sufficiently large enough preschool and kindergarten to make the eventual 8<sup>th</sup> grade class a healthy size that allows for good socialization, various extra-curricular activities, and stimulating class discussions on important topics in theology, history, literature, science, and math. We are blessed to have two excellent new teachers joining our middle school this coming Fall as our principal shifts to working full-time in administration and our middle school numbers will also be increasing next year, which is a wonderful sign for the future. However, the key is to think not just about the 2025-26 academic year, but to think about the 2031-32 academic year. I want these wonderful new teachers to join our current teachers in being ready for a robust and even larger middle school when our next year's kindergarten begins its time in middle school.

We have plenty of work to do in order to build our school's enrollment and there will be plenty of challenges, especially as there are simply so few children being born now (the U.S. is averaging a 1.66 birth rate right now and the fertility rate has decreased to an historic low in the past few years). Nevertheless, each challenge presents its opportunities and as we reflect upon the challenge and opportunity to rebuild our school's enrollment in the upcoming years, I cannot think of a better time of the year to embark upon this than during the Easter Season. We are currently hearing about the early decades of the Church when we read from the Acts of the Apostles at Mass each weekend. The passages from Acts remind us that, with God's grace and our faithfulness, nothing is impossible. If a handful of disciples from Galilee could become the vessels by which the Gospel would overtake the world, then certainly several thousand parishioners in Oakdale can use their time, talent, and treasure to breathe new life into their parish school. Together, let us make Transfiguration a guiding light for all who live in our community so that our school may thrive and draw many families to Christ and His Church.


