Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Each of us is called to a life of holiness. God has created us to be saints, and to know, love and serve Him in this life so that we can spend eternity with Him in the next. One way we are able to grow in this holiness is to entrust ourselves to Mary, allowing her to take us by the hand as a benevolent mother, and to bring us to Jesus. Of all humans who have ever lived, Mary knows, loves, and serves Jesus the best. So, we can place ourselves in her tender hands, and learn from her how to best live our lives and to allow the fruits and gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow freely. Also, as we see in the Wedding at Cana, Mary is a terrific intercessor, asking Jesus on our behalf for the graces that we need in particular moments of our life. So consecrating ourselves to Mary is really to consecrate ourselves to Jesus, but through Mary. Mary then takes us under her wings to teach us total surrender to Christ and how to live our faith as we are called.

With this in mind, I would like to invite you all to join us in the coming month to participate in consecrating our parish to Mary. Entrusting ourselves or our parish to Mary goes back to when Jesus entrusted the disciple John to her at the foot of the cross. In the late 1600s St. Louis de Montfort formalized a method to deepen our relationship with Jesus through Mary. This has also been treated more recently by Fr. Gaitley.

How do we go about doing this? I invite you, even if you have done it before, to obtain a copy of the book 33 Days to Morning Glory by Fr. Michael Gaitley and to begin on November 5th. This will end with consecrating our parish to Mary on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8th. Another option is to go to Formed.org and to watch one of their episodes on 33 Days to Morning Glory each week (There is also an introductory episode and a final one). This series is set up as a retreat, so you are certainly welcome to get together with some fellow parishioners to participate together and continue to build community. (Of note, next week's bulletin will have information on how to access the content on Formed). I look forward to opening our parish even more to the care and intercession of our Blessed Mother, and am confident that this will lead us to an even more fruitful life in the Spirit as we seek Jesus above all else.
