## Mass at the Cathedral & MCCL March for Life on January 22<sup>nd</sup>!

On Sunday, January 22, you are invited to attend Mass at the Cathedral of Saint Paul at 12:00PM followed by the annual **MCCL March for Life**. The March for Life will begin at 2:00 on the State Capitol grounds, followed by a brief program at 2:30 p.m. MCCL will announce their 2023 legislative agenda and introduce pro-life lawmakers and officials.

This Mass commemorates the millions of lives lost to abortion and the many women and men wounded by abortion's aftermath. It is also an opportunity to recognize those who exemplify pro-life work in our local communities with the Saint John Paul II Champion for Life Award.

Participation in the annual MCCL March for Life is more important than ever. Although the overturning of *Roe v. Wade* has allowed states to protect unborn children, in Minnesota abortion-on-demand continues and lawmakers are even planning to pursue extreme new pro-abortion legislation.

The St. Boniface Knights of Columbus have generously contributed funds to provide transportation to this event. The bus will promptly depart from the St. Boniface Church parking lot at 10:00 and return at **4 p.m.** A free will offering will be taken on the bus to help cover transportation costs. Bus starts at St. Boni leaving at 10:00AM, stops at Our Lady of the Lake in Mound 10:15AM and then at Lund's in Wayzata at 10:45.
