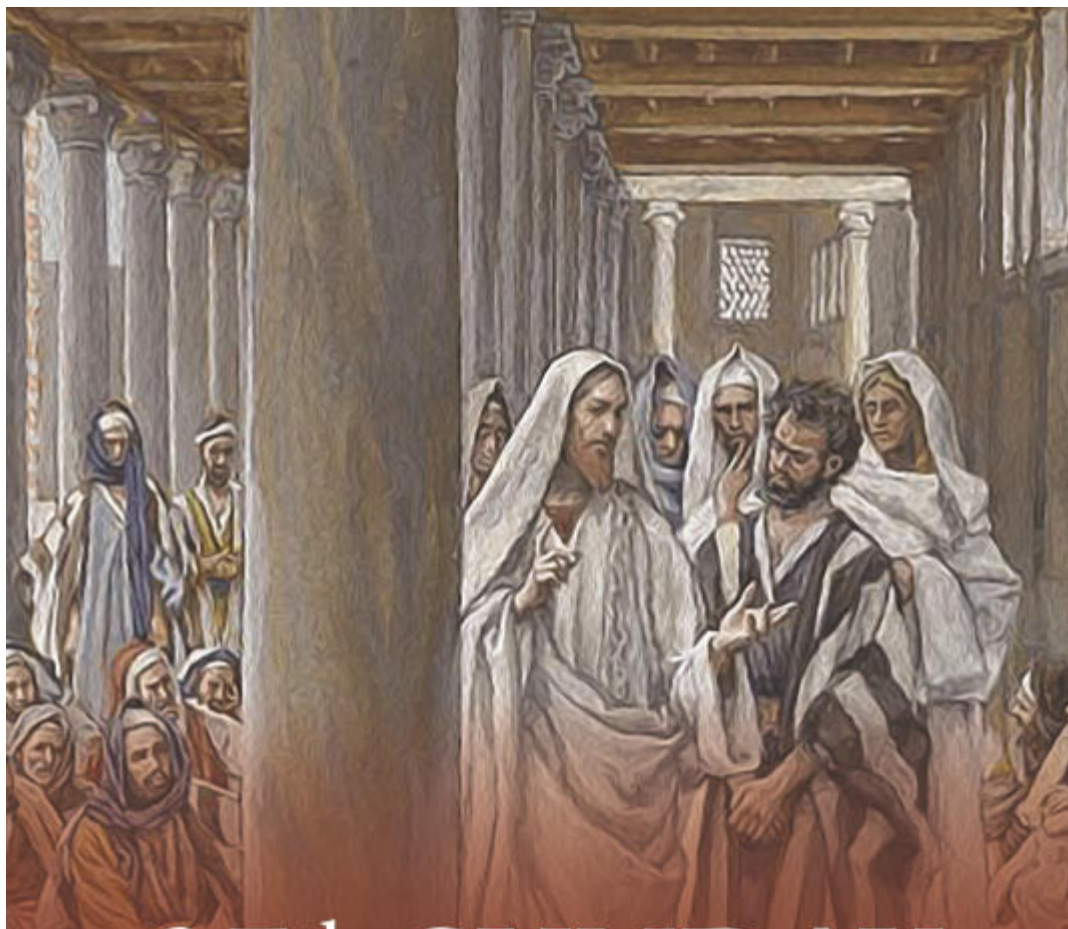

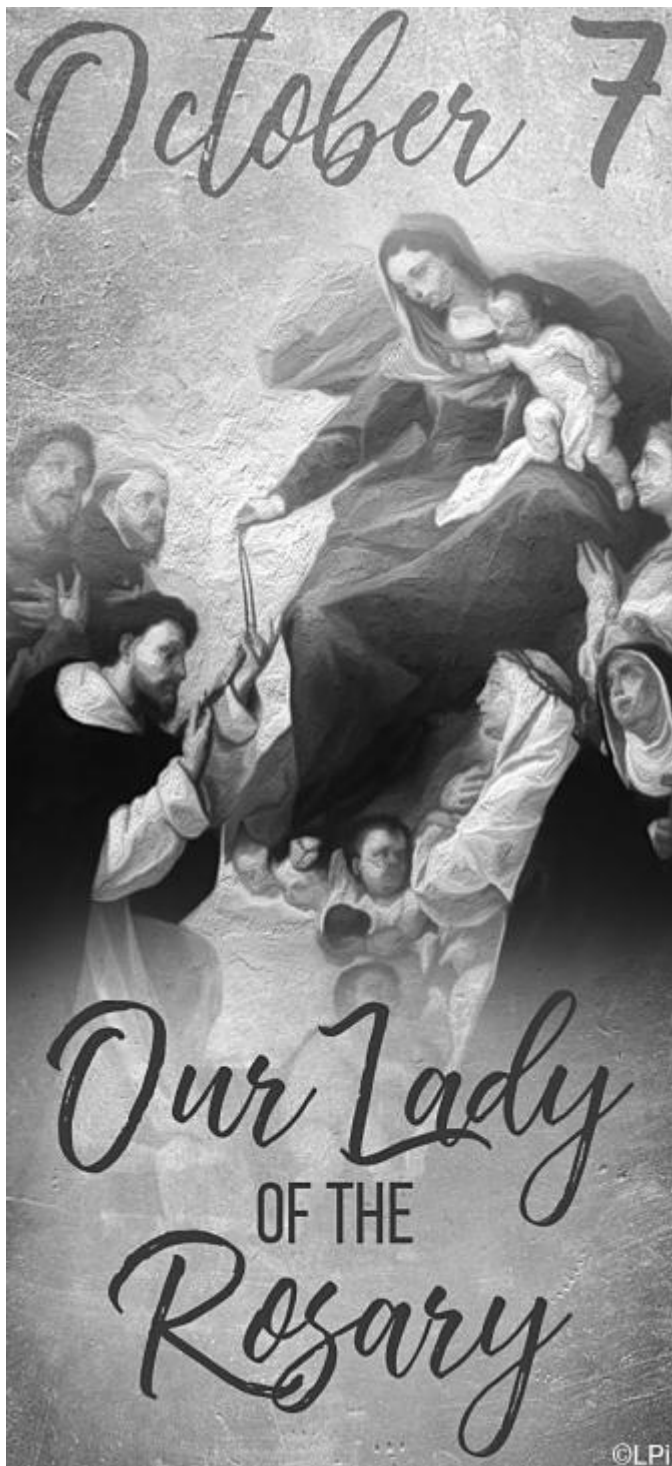

## Faith Reflections

St. John Henry Cardinal Newman has three feast days! Because he was an Anglican priest before he was a Catholic priest, the Church of England celebrates him on August 11, the day of his birth in 1801, and the Episcopal Church celebrates him on February 21, the day of his death in 1890. We remember him on October 9, the day he converted to the Catholic Church in 1845.

Before his conversion, friends told him that if he went through with his plan, he would never be able to come to Oxford again, he would lose all his friends, and he would lose his good income. Newman answered, "What is all that to one Holy Communion?"

St. John Henry Newman, pray for us, that we might have a great love for Christ and His Church. Below is one of his most famous quotes.

*"God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons."*

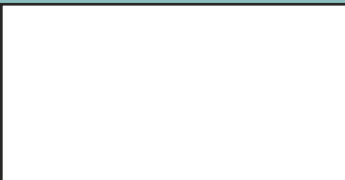

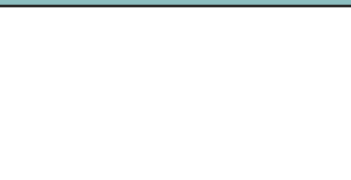
