### Faith Reflections

This Monday, August 23, we celebrate the Memorial of St. Rose of Lima, the first canonized saint of the New World. Baptized with the name Isabel, she was called Rose because of her extraordinary beauty. From an early age, she had many suitors, but she was determined to consecrate herself to God. Since her beauty posed an obstacle to her vocation, she deliberately disfigured herself by rubbing her face with pepper and lime.

Our culture puts so much importance on youth, appearance and beauty. No doubt, St. Rose was countercultural for her day too. Her name is often chosen by girls preparing for Confirmation. They probably admire her bravery and independence, and her willingness to show that beauty isn't only on the outside.

Our girls and young women need our prayers so that they too have the courage to be virtuous and follow their own dreams. I came across these [10 Ways to Pray for Your Daughter](http://www.imom.com). ([www.imom.com](http://www.imom.com))

I pray that she will choose her friends carefully. (Proverbs 12:26)
