Why register at a parish?

Over time, all of us tend to begin taking things for granted. As parishes, we have long taken for granted that people know what it means to register at a parish, and why you would want to do that. Yet, through conversations with Catholics in the pews, we have realized that's not always the case. Recently, I came across a good explanation of parish registration in another church's bulletin. They asked these questions: "Are you a registered parishioner? Do you find OLP to be your home? Do you find peace at OLP? Do you find

yourself to be a part of the OLP Community? Have you registered as a parishioner?"

They also noted that it has become more common to require godparents, confirmation sponsors, those getting married, those seeking annulments, etc. to provide documentation that they are parishioners at a parish and have received their sacraments of initiation. We have noticed that too, and are happy to provide that documentation; however, the only thing we have to base it on is our registration database. This is one of many reasons that we encourage you to register if you consider OLP your church home. 
