Holy Land Collection

When is it?

This coming weekend, we will be taking up a collection in support of the shrines in the Holy Land, and well as the Christians living there. I realize that we just had our Mission Appeal at the end of August, and this weekend we are contributing to the recovery efforts in Beirut, Lebanon. We usually try to avoid having several such appeals in a short space of time; however, this fall we could not help it. The Lebanon collection is not something we could schedule in advance, since it is in response to the explosion that occurred there last month. The Mission Appeal was pushed later in the summer due to COVID concerns. The same is true for next weekend's Holy Land collection—it traditionally takes place on Good Friday. As you know, public Masses were completely shut down during most of Lent and Holy Week, so it could not take place at that time. This coming Sunday, September 13th was chosen as the make-up date, because it is close to the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14th), a feast which shares a similar theme to Good Friday.

What does the Holy Land collection support?

According to the Franciscans working there, it helps maintain the Holy Sepulcher (the church housing the tomb of Jesus), the Basilica of the Nativity (the place where Christ was born), and other holy places. It sustains the parishes and schools in the land where Jesus walked. It assists the homeless, migrants, and refugees displaced by war and conflict. This year in particular, it sustains the Christian communities that depend on pilgrims and tourists for their work and livelihood, since travel has been greatly reduced by the pandemic.

How can you give?

You can give in person at Mass on September 12th-13th. You can also mail in or drop off a contribution at the parish office—just be sure it is clearly marked for the Holy Land Collection. Finally, you can use ConnectNow Giving on our website. Simply select the Holy Land Fund. Thanks in advance for your generosity.



Synod Prayer and Study Series

Like everything, the Archdiocesan Synod timeline has been adjusted due to COVID. Certain things have been rescheduled, and others are being offered in a modified format. Next up are the Synod Prayer and Study Series, which are beginning right now. Many sessions (if not all of them) will be led by Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens. I highly encourage you to join in for these series.

When do they start?

The first series on praying with the Scriptures starts this weekend, September 13th. They are virtual, live-streamed events, so you can also participate on another day at your convenience. There are five parts to each series. (The second series, on Healing and Hope, starts on October 18th).

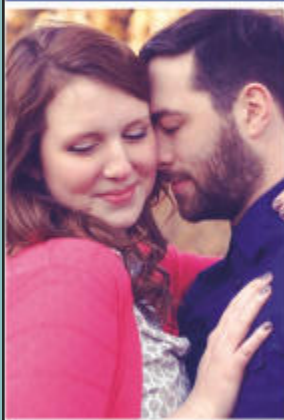
