### A Saint for Our Times

One in five adults in the U.S. experience mental illness. During this month of mental health awareness, we remember St. Dymphna whose feast day is celebrated on May 15. She is a Saint who powerfully intercedes on behalf of those who suffer from mental illness.

St. Dymphna was born in Ireland in the eighth century to a pagan father, a king of one of the many kingdoms of Ireland, and a Christian mother. When Dymphna was fourteen years old her mother died. Becoming mentally distraught at the loss of his wife, Dymphna's father fell into a psychosis. His advisors suggested he marry again. He agreed but only to someone as beautiful as his wife had been. Since there was no one to match the beauty of his wife except his own daughter Dymphna, the advisors suggested that he marry her. He became obsessed with marrying Dymphna. She escaped to Geel, Belgium with her priest-friend Fr. Gerebernus, a member of the court, and his wife. The king soon found out where they were and went with some of his soldiers to bring her back. When Dymphna refused to marry him he ordered his men to kill Fr. Gerebernus and Dymphna, but when they balked at killing her, the king killed her himself.

Dymphna and Fr. Gerebernus were buried in a nearby cave. Some years later, the people of Geel rediscovered the cave and decided to inter the bodies in the local church. Soon miracles and cures began to occur through the intercession of Dymphna. Her fame as the patroness of victims of nervous diseases and mental disorders quickly spread. She soon became the patron saint of those suffering from mental illness.

*Lord God, Who has graciously chosen St. Dymphna to be the patroness of those afflicted with mental and nervous disorders, grant through the prayers of this pure, youthful martyr, relief and consolation to all who suffer from mental illness, and especially to those for whom we now pray. Enjoy an eclectic program full of music ranging from the concert hall to Tin Pan Alley and from the sanctuary to the jazz club.

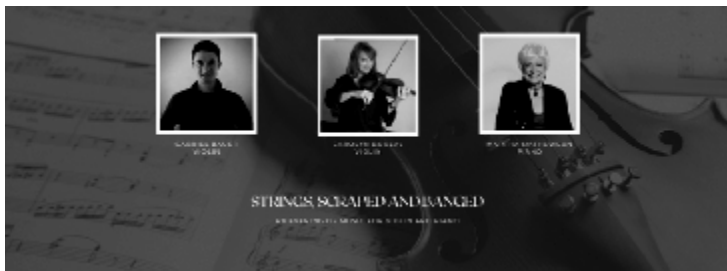
Featuring violinists Gabriel Bauer and Carolyn Boulay and pianist Martha Mathewson.
