From Fr. Ellis

Corpus Christi



Next weekend is the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus. Specifically, this observance is about the presence of the Lord's Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist. You may recall that in past years we had been working on reviving the tradition of holding a Eucharistic Procession on this feast day. With the relaxing of many of the pandemic restrictions, it may seem like something we could have done this year. However, when the time came for us to decide whether or not we could/would have a procession, the restrictions were still in force—and there was little indication that they would change when they did. With little advance notice, we aren't able to make all the necessary preparations for such a procession.

However, we still want to do something to honor the presence of Jesus's Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist. So we will have an hour of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament—commonly known as Adoration—next Sunday afternoon, June 6, starting at 2 pm.

The Holy Eucharist is the sacrament of sacraments, the source and summit of our faith. Though spoken of in such lofty terms, this sacrament is far from ethereal, intangible, or unintelligible. It is the concrete presence of Christ Jesus, really and truly with us. Because of this, the Church instructs her priests that promoting the understanding of, appreciation for, and devotion to the Eucharist is key among their duties and responsibilities.

Recently, this has been brought home to me through my spiritual reading. I've been working through a book called *In Sinu Jesu*. It's basically the prayer journal of a Benedictine monk, recording his conversations with Jesus. In it, the Lord says many times how deeply He desires priests and all the faithful to spend time with Him in the Eucharist. He gave us this sacrament so that He could be with us. Just like it would pain a friend if he or she came a long distance to visit us—only to find that we were not interested in spending any time with him or her—so it pains Jesus when we do not spend time with Him present in our churches. Similarly, it gives Him great joy when we do take time to visit Him. After all, that is what our prayer and worship are all about: encountering the living God, who is real and who wants to enter into a real relationship with us.
