What's with the Latin?

If you were at Mass for Corpus Christi this weekend, you undoubtedly noticed that there was a Latin version of the Gloria for you to sing printed in the Worship Aid. You may also have heard a cantor or member of the choir singing this same one on other Holy Days. Many of them found this setting challenging, both melodically and linguistically.

So why would we ask the assembly to sing this setting?

This particular Gloria is one of the most popular settings in Latin throughout the Catholic Church, and with good reason: many feel that the melody is beautiful, but after spending time learning it, one discovers that it is not as challenging as it seems at first read. There are very distinguishable patterns, but they do not occur frequently enough that the chant becomes banal. This Gloria is sung all over the world, so there is a good chance that if you attend Mass at a Cathedral in or out of the country that you might hear it one day and be able to participate. One of our choir members, when visiting Rome, noted that the Sanctus (Holy, Holy) was the same one that we sing during Lent and even though we sing it in English here, knowing the melody of that simple chant enabled him to sing the Latin with the assembly in Rome! It was a powerful experience of the Church's universality.

While we often use the Vernacular (our native language) in the liturgy, "pride of place" is given to Latin in the same modern Liturgical Documents that allowed the Mass to be celebrated in English. The language of the Church is Latin so having parts that we say together unites us with not only those all over the world singing the same Latin Gloria, but with all those throughout the centuries of the church that have sung in Latin.

If this setting is not for you, not to worry, we will not be permanently singing this setting of the Gloria; like all of our music, it will rotate. You will hear this Gloria again, but there will be a good amount of time when you will get to sing the English Gloria that you know.

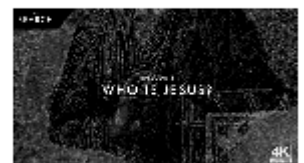
Students could be found lounging in the grass with big smiles (and pizza sauce) on their faces.
