From Fr. Ellis

The Church is Missionary



As announced elsewhere, next Sunday will be our annual summer Mission Appeal. This year a priest named Fr. Jose will be coming to ask us to help support the work of the Vincentian Congregation, of which he is a member. Based in India, they do mission work throughout that country as well as in Africa. Fr. Jose will be covering the Masses and preaching next weekend, giving him an opportunity to explain in more detail the nature of the work that they do.

There's a lot of wisdom to these yearly mission appeals that the Archdiocese coordinates. First, it gives us a chance to learn about the works of charity and evangelization that Catholics are doing in other parts of the world. This helps keep us from becoming too provincial in our perception of the Church. On the one hand, the Church is universal, meaning that our beliefs and worship are the same throughout the world. Yet at the same time, the challenges and blessings that the faithful experience can be widely different in the various parts of the globe.

Second (and more importantly) mission appeals remind us that the main activity or goal of the Church is mission. This is what Jesus repeatedly told his followers, especially after His resurrection: "Go and make disciples of all nations." (Mt. 28:19) It's in the psalms as well, such as in Psalm 105 where it says, "Make known his deeds among the peoples...tell of all his wonderful works." (Ps. 105:1-2) Living in a fallen world, it is a temptation for us to focus on ourselves—even when it comes to our Faith. It is indeed true that the sacraments, prayer, the teachings of our Faith, etc. are of great benefit to our own souls; they are the means that Jesus uses to bring us to salvation. But they are not merely given to us for our use; they are given for the benefit of all. For all these reasons, whenever we lose sight of the missionary aspect of discipleship, we are missing the very core of following Jesus. For He came "not to be served, but to serve." (Mk 10:45)

So, I ask you to be attentive and generous when Fr. Jose is here for the mission appeal. It will not only benefit the work of the Vincentian Congregation, but it will also help remind all of us of the universality and missionary nature of the Church.

As a side note, since Fr. Jose will be covering confessions and Mass next weekend, I will make use of the opportunity to take some time away. Besides the weekend of July 24-25, I will be gone through Friday, July 30.
