Rest in peace, Fr. Tim Nolan



A week ago Friday, Fr. Tim Nolan passed away at the age of 82, having served as a priest for 54 years. This week I learned that he had spent a number of years assigned to St. Kevin's. A handful of people who were originally from St. Kevin's saw his obituary and told me that they remembered him. My connection to Fr. Tim was through another parish, the Church of St. Paul in Ham Lake, of which he was the founding pastor. My family lived not far from that parish growing up and were members there for a few years. I remember him as being a cheerful, laid-back guy (Mass always started at least five if not ten minutes late!) with a great love of prayer and the Lord Jesus. He was a leader in the Catholic charismatic renewal movement, seeking the Holy Spirit's guidance and gifts. It must have been in the water for him growing up because all three of his sisters entered religious life as well! In fact, I learned that at least one of them used to work and/or minister at St. Kevin's when Fr. Tim was there as well.

After retirement, Fr. Tim went to live and serve at Pacem in Terris Retreat Center in Isanti, an organization he was involved in from its earliest days. He continued to guide and teach those making retreats how to recognize and follow the Holy Spirit's work in their lives. I've been to Pacem in Terris many times, and it is indeed a peaceful place where one can spend time listening to God's voice. I highly recommend it if you are looking for a place to take some time for retreat. The individual cabins are rather rustic and afford a lot of solitude, but they also have rooms in the main building that are more accessible and don't require you to "rough it" near as much.

Fr. Tim's funeral was held this Saturday, August 28 at the Church of St. Paul in Ham Lake. He was laid to rest at Resurrection Cemetery. May he rest in peace.

Anointing of the Sick

Our annual Anointing of the Sick Mass will be on Friday, September 10 at 5 pm.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it is God's will, the person be physically healed of illness.

But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.
