Pumpkin Patch arrives this week!



As announced previously, our third annual Pumpkin Patch begins this week! It starts on Tuesday, October 12 and will be open 11 am until 7 pm daily until October 31 (or until we run out of the 2,000+ pumpkins that will be delivered). The proceeds from the patch will be used to support religious education and sacrament preparation for those at both church and school.

As in past years, we have a lot of goals for this young tradition at Our Lady of Peace. We do seek to raise money to help pass on the faith to the next generation. We hope that it serves as the backdrop for many fun family memories as we welcome the crisp autumn days. Third, we want it to be a way for us to get to know the community, and for them in turn to get to know us. Many people do not realize that there is a school tucked away in the neighborhood, just half a block away from 54th Street. In addition, events like this can be a “bridge” connecting people to the faith. As just one example, I have seen the Holy Spirit moving among the young adults that have been moving into our neighborhoods. He’s been showing them that the desires of their hearts are fulfilled by Him, through prayer, the sacraments, and our Faith. But they often need a bridge, so that their experience of God drawing their hearts can be connected with a community of believers to support them in their faith.
