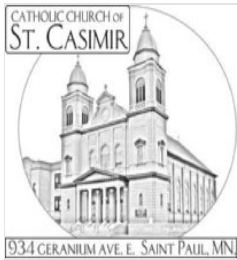

## Candidacy Mass for Dominic Wolters with Archbishop Hebda

On Sunday, June 16, Dominic Wolters will be admitted as a Candidate for Holy Orders at the 9 am Mass by Archbishop Hebda. Candidacy is the first formal step towards ordination in the Church, consisting of the public declaration by both the seminarian and the Church that he is seeking ordination after sufficient discernment and preparation. Once a seminarian has been accepted as a candidate, he can begin to wear the black shirt and white collar for certain functions.

Dominic will be continuing his seminary formation at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, starting late-July. Please keep him and all men studying for the priesthood in your prayers.

There will be a reception for Dominic, after Mass, in the Parish Hall. Everyone welcome to attend.

## Divine Word Missionaries

Fr. Tuan Khoi Hoang, SVD will be at St. Casimir on June 22 and 23 to speak about the many ministries of his religious community, Divine Word Missionaries. They are an international religious community of missionary priests and Brothers serving in 79 countries helping to build chapels, celebrate the sacraments and spread the Word of God in remote mission communities.

Fr. Tuan was born and raised in Stockton, California. He entered formation in 2000 and was ordained a Divine Word Missionary priest in 2018. Fr. Tuan has served in Vietnam for two years and in Ecuador for three. He recently returned from Ecuador, where he worked with the mestizos (people who share European and indigenous heritage) as well as with the indigenous in parish ministries. Fr. Tuan currently serves as Associate Dean of Students at Divine Word College in Epworth, Iowa.

Nearly 6,000 active Divine Word Missionaries minister in the far corners of the world. They build hospitals to care for the sick and build schools to educate the poor. They teach the hungry to farm. They provide life's necessities—water, food and shelter—in impoverished communities. These priests and Brothers help those neglected and forgotten by society to build a better future. They also foster vibrant Catholic communities of service and faith around the world.

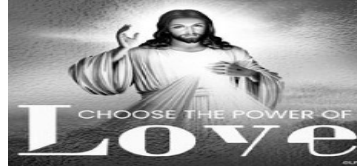

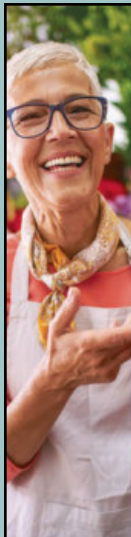
