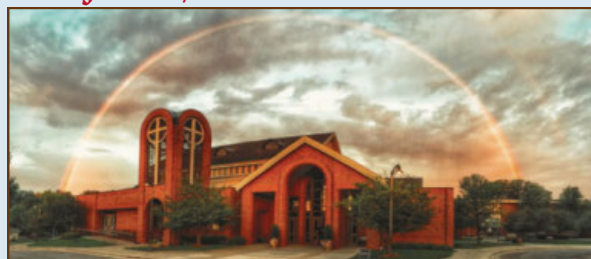

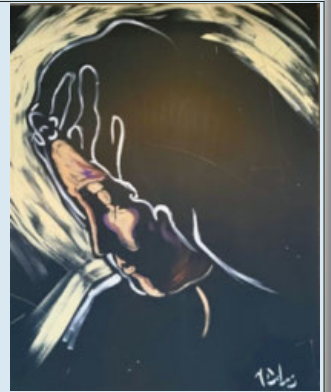

Faith Reflections

Happy Mothers' Day to all the mothers of St. James and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parishes! On NPR, I once heard the poem "Beannacht / Blessing" read by the author himself, John O'Donohue. You might imagine him reading with a touch of an Irish accent. O'Donohue was an Irish poet and philosopher, and a former priest who passed away in 2008. The words below remind me of what I wish for my Mom now that she is older, and her seeing, hearing, and understanding not as they once were. I hope that others might use this poem to pray for their mothers and grandmothers today. (Note: The word, *Beannacht* means "Blessing" in the Irish language. *Beannacht Libh* means "Blessing to you" and it is used in saying "Goodbye".)

Beannacht / Blessing

On the day when the weight deadens on your shoulders and you stumble, may the clay dance to balance you.

And when your eyes freeze behind the grey window and the ghost of loss gets into you, may a flock of colours, indigo, red, green and azure blue, come to awaken in you a meadow of delight.

When the canvas frays in the currach of thought and a stain of ocean blackens beneath you, may there come across the waters a path of yellow moonlight to bring you safely home.

May the nourishment of the earth be yours, may the clarity of light be yours, may the fluency of the ocean be yours, may the protection of the ancestors be yours.

And so may a slow wind work these words of love around you, an invisible cloak to mind your life.
