Reflection

LESSER-KNOWN SAINTS: BLESSED FRANZ JÄGERSTÄTTER

Born in 1907, Franz grew up working as a farmer in rural Austria. He married Franziska and had three daughters. He was known for his ordinary faith and humility, as he did not draw attention to himself.

As the Nazi spirit became more fervent in his home country, he began thinking deeply about obedience to legitimate authority and obedience to God, along with mortality, eternal life, and Jesus' own Passion. He was not part of a resistance or a revolutionary, but he was the only citizen in his town to vote against the annexation of Austria by Germany in 1938. He didn't follow a certain ideology or a particular political party but acted according to the law of Christ and His Church.

He was drafted to serve into the Germany army in 1940, but was convinced that participation in the war was a serious sin. He received a deferment, and after returning home, he decided any future call-up had to be met with his refusal to fight. Despite his countrymen kneeling when Hitler entered into Vienna and Catholic churches in his area being forced to fly the swastika flag, he was at peace with his decision and the backlash that came with it.

He was called up a final time for military service, and announced his refusal to fight, offering to carry out non-violent services. This was denied. He was imprisoned and subject to trial, where he declared, "I cannot obey if it would mean doing evil. I must obey God rather than men." He was condemned to death by guillotine for sedition. He showed how true courage often looks calm and steadfast, not loud or aggressive. While in prison, he prayed for his executioners and wrote letters to his wife and children, encouraging them to remain faithful.

He was executed in 1943, at the age of 36. He died as a martyr of conscience. His death was not a political act, but a spiritual witness. It is about living and dying according to God's law rather than human pressure. Moreover, his conscience was well-formed. His decisions were guided by prayer, Church teaching, and reflection on right and wrong. He was beatified in 2007, with his wife and daughters in attendance.

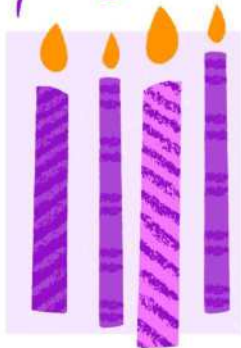

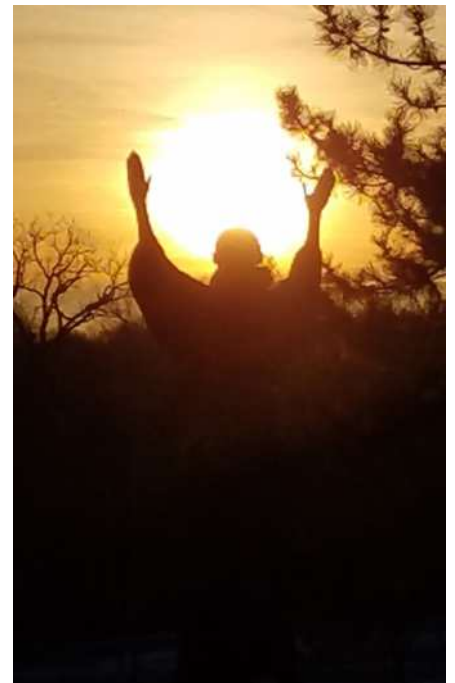

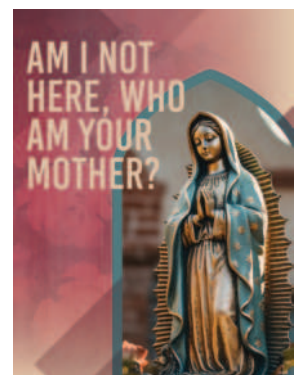
