





## **PASTOR'S PEN**

Pope Francis's intention for the month of July runs like this: "We pray for the elderly, who represent the roots and memory of a people; may their experience and wisdom help young people to look towards the future with hope and responsibility." Next Sunday, July 24th, is celebrated as the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly. Last year, Pope Francis announced a new

celebration in honor of all grandparents and the elderly to be celebrated every year on the fourth Sunday in July. Aging in the Bible is said to be a sign of experience. The Lord promises His continued love and concern for the elderly. "I will be your God throughout your lifetime until your hair is white with age. I made you and I will care for you. I will carry you along and save you (Isaiah 46:4). Respect for elders is a trait found in almost all cultures. Cultures



promote honor and respect for elders. For us Christians, it is linked to one of the Commandments of God.



In the Wisdom writings of the Bible, we are advised: "Listen to your father, who gave you life, and do not despise your mother when she is old" (Proverbs 23:22). St Paul deepens the application of the commandment: "Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever" (1 Timothy 5:8).

Elders are reservoirs of wisdom and experience that no culture or community can ignore. Yet, the elderly experience neglect and disrespect in all cultures of the world. The nature and form of physical, material, emotional, relational and spiritual neglect may vary from culture to culture. Too often, I hear from the elderly: "oh, it is no fun





getting old." At times I wonder whether it is an indictment of our culture's attitude and care of the elderly.

Have we learned anything from the Pandemic that ravaged our lives for almost three years? Perhaps, it has helped us realize more of things that truly matter- life, family, relationship and God. Let us take care of the elderly in our community. As Christians, we are called to be counter-cultural! Families have the duty to meet the needs of the elderly. Very often the spiritual care of the elderly has been neglected by families. In the Scripture readings, we see God's care for the elderly couple Abraham and Sarah. In the Gospel story, we hear how Jesus teaches Martha how to stay focused on what is truly important. Reflect how often we keep fretting over unimportant things.

A parish has a duty to give adequate spiritual care, and attention to everyone in the family, including the elderly. I strive to visit the sick, the homebound and those in the Care Centers. We also have volunteers who are ready to visit the elderly. I request the parish families to provide information of their elderly living either in Assisted living facilities or homes. The information will help us to reach out to them. Prior to the Covid, we had a special mass and fellowship for the elderly once every month. We hope to resume it as soon as we can arrange it. A community's respect for the elderly manifests itself in the care given them. With our love and care, let us make their lives rich and beautiful in the evening of their lives.
