#### PASTORAL LETTER FROM REVEREND MICHAEL BECKER

#### CONSECRATION OF RUSSIA

As I write this column, Pope Francis is scheduled to consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Friday, March 25, 2022, during a Penance service in St Peter's Basilica. The same act is simultaneously to be performed in Fatima by Cardinal Konrad Krajewski. The reason for the consecration is because on July 13, 1917, in Fatima, Portugal, our Lady appeared to three little children and asked for the consecration of Russia to her Immaculate Heart, stating that if this request was not fulfilled, Russia would spread "its errors throughout the world, promoting wars and persecution of the Church." She continued, "The good will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to suffer, various nations will be destroyed." On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a consecration of the whole world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and on March 25, 1984, Pope John Paul II did the same. The actions of the two popes no doubt contributed to the end of WWII and the dismantling of the Soviet bloc. Sister Lucia of Fatima confirmed that the solemn and universal acts fulfilled what our Lady asked for at Fatima. Nevertheless, I cannot help but think that we need more from Russia. The world needs Russia to return wholeheartedly to her Christian roots and in so doing to put an end to communistic atheism. Furthermore, as she is the springboard for modern day abortion, it would be fitting that she of all countries would eliminate the tragic holocaust, becoming a witness for all other countries to follow suit. Finally, she is the lynchpin for Christian unity. Should the Russian Orthodox Church find it in her heart and theology to reunite with the Roman Catholic Church, many other Orthodox Churches and even Protestants would find tremendous inspiration to join the movement, fulfilling a great desire which rests in the heart of Jesus: "I pray . . . that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me" (John 18:20-21).

The glorious Russian Orthodox Church has some great saints, including the wonder-working St. Seraphim of Sarov who became a monk, and then in turn a hermit! One day bandits came to his hermitage in the woods to steal what they could find. They beat him with the wood of an ax until he fell unconscious. As a result, he walked hunchback for the rest of his life. Nevertheless, St. Seraphim went to the courts, interceding on behalf of the robbers, forgiving them entirely. A disciple named Motovilov once interviewed St. Seraphim, but could hardly look at the holy man, for St. Seraphim's face was "brighter than the sun." A second holy man of the Russian Orthodox Tradition is St. John of San Francisco, also known as John of Shanghai, because he served in China for a time as a bishop in the Russian Orthodox Church outside of Russia. When the communists took over in China, he and other Russian Orthodox members fled to the Philippines, a number ultimately landing on the west coast of the United States. St. John of San Francisco lived a very holy life, full of fasting and prayer. He ardently loved and served the sick, orphans and widows. He is an incorruptible saint, his body lying in a glass sarcophagus in the Holy Virgin Cathedral: Joy of All Who Sorrow, on Geary Boulevard in San Francisco, a great place for a spiritual pilgrimage.



I love to pray the Rosary, and I know many of our parishioners do so daily, on behalf of family members, the Church, and world, including Russia. One other spiritual discipline which individuals could undertake as recommended by Mary at Fatima, is the first Saturdays devotion. Our Lady of Fatima promised "to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all those who, in order to make reparation to me, on the First Saturday of five successive months, go to confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary." The Rosary and the First Saturdays Devotion are two great ways to assist in the transformation of our world.
