## WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

### Shakopee Catholic Cemeteries Decorations Policy

Any questions regarding this policy or our three cemeteries, please call the parish office at 952-445-1319.

**Starting Memorial Day weekend:** Grave decorations may be placed on graves in approved pots and vases through Labor Day each year. Please do not put any loose items on the ground or headstones. Loose items make it difficult for our groundskeepers when they are mowing and pose a danger when the blades eject them. If unapproved items are found near a gravesite they will be removed, the family will be notified if possible, or at the Shakopee Catholic Cemetery, the items will be placed by the shed for pickup.

**After Labor Day:** ALL decorations, including temporary flower stands, must be removed to allow for winter cleanup and in order to have access to the graves. Flowerpots on poles/stands must be removed before winter because they freeze in and require a jackhammer to remove for access at the time of a funeral.

## Usher & Greeter

Ushers are men and women who greet and seat people as they enter the church, monitor the needs of the assembly, assist with the collection, and distribute materials at the end of the liturgy. This opportunity requires a friendly, cheerful, and helpful disposition. You are the initial face of our parish as people arrive.



## Lectionary Reader

Readers are women and men who proclaim the Word of God by reading the First and Second Readings at the Sunday and Holy Day liturgies. This requires training in projecting one's voice with confidence and proclaiming the Scripture clearly and distinctly.



## Altar Server

Servers are boys and girls grade four and older who assist at the altar during Sunday and Holy Day liturgies. There are also opportunities to serve at the SACS school Mass and funerals. This position requires training and reverence for what happens during the liturgy.



## Extraordinary Minister

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion distribute the Body and Blood of Christ at Sunday and Holy Day liturgies. It requires reverence and an understanding of the sacredness of this ministry. The Eucharist must be important in your life. To distribute Holy Communion one must be properly trained and commissioned by an SJA priest.

There are many opportunities for you to volunteer to help at Mass!
