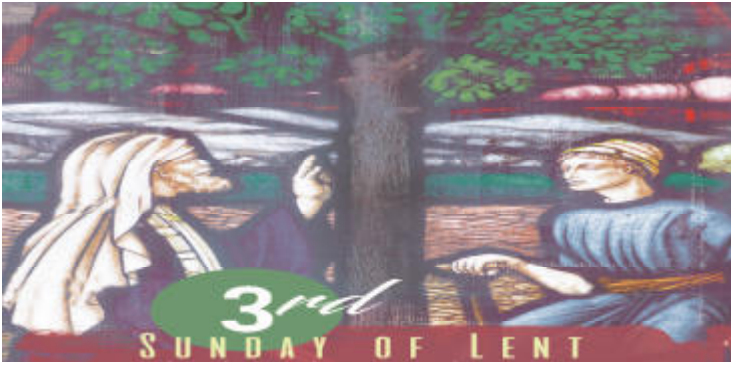

**School Building Update:**

We want to provide you with an update from the Sacred Heart School Transition Committee. The committee was formed to identify potential uses for the building following the transition back to Sacred Heart Parish later this year. There are many practical considerations, such as maintenance costs and insurance that the committee is currently working through. However, the main goal is to identify viable uses for the building, so that it will remain a vital part of the neighborhood, and will also remain accessible as a gathering place for Sacred Heart parishioners. Discussions have been held with possible tenants for a portion of the building, with the Boys and Girls Club, and possible charitable uses, such as an EMBARC satellite office and providing space for Faith Formation. The committee meets the first week of each month, led by Don Johnston. As you can imagine there are many moving parts, but we will continue to provide you with regular updates and developments. Suggestions and assistance are always welcome.
