From Fr. Paul's Desk: You are My Son; today have I Fathered you. Lk 3:22

The Christmas season, celebrating the Self-revelation of God through Jesus comes to an end with the feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. In times past, God spoke in partial and various ways to our ancestors through the prophets; in these last days, he spoke to us through a Son, Jesus Christ. (Hebrew 1:1) Christmas is the feast of God's Self-revelation to the Jews, and Epiphany celebrates God's Self-revelation to the Gentiles. At His Baptism in the Jordan, Christ reveals Himself to repentant sinners. It is the Self-Revelation of the Holy Trinity. The Holy Spirit reveals Himself as a dove and God the Father proclaimed Jesus as His beloved Son. Today is the feast day of our own Baptisma day or our birthday as members of the Holy Catholic Church. The Sacrament of Baptism is the door to the Church and the gate which gives access to all other Sacraments. Through the Sacrament of Baptism, we are purified from our original and personal sins. By Baptism, we are children, then we are heirs- heirs of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus Christ, members of His Church and temples of the Holy Spirit. (cf. Romans 8:17) By the anointed with the Holy Oil and Holy Spirit, we share the three offices of Christ, i. e; prophetic office, priestly office and Kingly office. We have been clothed with Christ and enlightened by Christ's light. It is a special day for us to renew our Baptismal promises. Let us profess, "I do" and practice what we profess. Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth? I do. Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father? I do. Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? I do. Do you reject Satan? I do. And all his works? I do. And all his empty promises? I do. This is our Faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen.
