

From Fr. Paul's Desk: They have no wine. Jn. 2:3

We have been celebrating the Solemnities of God's revelation to human beings. Christmas is the feast of God's Self-revelation to the Jews, and Epiphany celebrates God's Self-revelation to the Gentiles. The Baptism of the Lord in the Jordan is the Self-Revelation of the Holy Trinity to all. This week Jesus reveals His Divine power by turning water into wine at a wedding. "Do whatever He tells you" is a life-transforming mantra given to us by Mother Mary. This is the only recorded command of Mary in the Bible. We always need to invite Jesus and Mary to remain with us in our homes because they are the best helpers for every solution to our family problems. It is important to be aware of miracles God is doing in our lives. As an uninvited guest in our families, God works daily miracles in our lives, protecting us from physical and moral dangers, providing for our needs, inspiring us, and strengthening us with His Holy Spirit. Every one of us and every married couple runs short of something at some time or other. We run short of patience, understanding, communication, love, appreciation, forgiveness, health, money or work. We need to know and accept our shortcomings and turn to Jesus to get a fresh supply of what we need to make our lives and family happier. On our part we need to do the best in whatever Jesus tells us to do. Throughout the Bible, marriage is the symbol of the Covenant relationship between God and His Chosen People. God is the Bridegroom and humanity is His beloved Bride. Another question is are we running short of our spiritual well-being? We might be running short of practicing our faith, following God's Commandments, teachings and obligations of the Church or being faithful to our parish church. We need to fill up the jars with water and then we will taste the best wine for prosperity on this earth and for our salvation. The only thing Jesus tells us to do is to love God and others.


You, Salvation of the Roman People, know what we need, and we are sure you will provide so that, as in Cana of Galilee, we may return to joy and to feasting after this time of trial.
