It is unbelievable that there are some Christians who persecute other Christians by taking advantage of the poor and the weak, destroy their neighbor's peace of mind and reputation, look down on people of a different color and social status. They live as if they never heard Jesus say: "Love your neighbor," as if they never heard St. Paul tells us: "Love is kind." So, we always need to keep our Faith in God by loving others. We might experience the pain of rejection, betrayal, violated trust, neglect or abuse by those closest to us. Let us try not to reject God and His teachings, and face any rejection with prophetic courage and optimism. God is always with us to deliver us from anyone who is against us. Let us not waver our Faith in Jesus.
