Beyond the nutrition and comfort of a hot breakfast, you will be bringing hope to those who need it most. Each casserole feeds 10 people, with 150 casseroles needed each week.

"Thank You" everybody who donated and helped with the sorting and delivery. Everything is given away free, to those who need the Coats-Hats-Gloves.



We collected for 12 weeks - each week there were five 20 pound bags for a total of 1200 pounds. They are distributed by UCAN, Partnership of Johnston, Catholic Worker and the Diocesan Refugee Program.

Most of the time we do not see the effect of this generosity but once we saw a Mother pick up a Coat and matching Hat and Gloves, for her child....then ask, if she can have all three items.

Baptism of the Lord ~ January 9, 2022

Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7; Psalm 29:1-2, 3-4, 3, 9-10; Titus 2:11-14, 3:4-7; Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

"Remember who you are and whose you are!"

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord serves as a good reminder about what each of us is called to...we are called to remember that we are unique individuals each made in the image and likeness of God, and we are all called to remember that we are indeed the children of God, and as such, we are to act like it!

Some people have suggested that our society is experiencing a loss of identity...we do not know who we are any more, except when we look at the labels we apply to ourselves or each other. Are we conservative or liberal; are we Democrat or Republican;



do we attend St. Pius or another Church; do our kids go to Dowling Catholic or Johnston or Urbandale....the list goes on...

I guess we are in a bit of an identity crisis, and I think all the polarities in our world are partly to blame. Our culture surely has added to the division and tension we find ourselves facing in our day to day living.

There is one truth, however, that would help us to heal these divisions and assist us in reclaiming our identity...and that is the reality of the Baptism that we share. In the gospel reading today we hear of the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan by John the Baptist...and the sky opens and a voice is heard saying, "This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased." While the sky did not open the day we were baptized, God did indeed claim us as His own. We too belong to God! And as a child of God, created in the image and likeness of God, we have been gifted with grace to lift up the world around us. If we remember that we are God's children, and that we are created to live in such a way that our Baptism means something...not only on the day of our Baptism, but every day of our lives...What a difference we will make. The promises made on the day of our Baptism are in reality our job description for the whole of our life...we are to bring Christ to the world by our presence in it; we are to proclaim the Word of God by our example; we are to make holy the world around us and work for the salvation of all humankind because that is what Jesus did, and that is what living in right-relationship with God calls us to do.

May we claim and reclaim our identity as God's children. May we hear God speak to us and say, "Remember who you are...you are my child and with you I am well pleased!" May we remember who we are and to whom we belong.




