From the Desk of Fr. Beckman:

We are now back into ordinary time in the Church's liturgical year and the second half of the fiscal year. I simply want to mention and give a big SHOUT of THANKS to all of our bulletin sponsors who so faithfully, year after year, place an advertisement for their business. **What your ad means to the parish:**

This sponsorship covers the cost of our bulletins each week which helps our overall budget. It's one expense we don't have to budget for. Your ad's been helping to ensure that every parishioner has access to a beautiful, full color, content rich document every week in hard-copy and online, while protecting church donations from bulletin costs. **For our sponsors:** I encourage every parishioner to support the businesses who support us through these ads. I pray and trust that your own income goals are exceeded for helping make our bulletin possible for us, bless you! May this new year bring you prosperity, peace and joy.

On another note, those businesses who participate in our SCRIP program also support us greatly. If you are not in the habit of using SCRIP, especially for food, gas, restaurants, Amazon, Mennards etc. I encourage you to do so. It is so easy. It just takes a little forethought and planning. It's just like cash so I always keep SCRIP cards in my wallet instead of cash, so I have them when I go shopping. Not to use SCRIP is like throwing money away. It costs you nothing up front other than a little time to drop by the school to pick it up. Ask for an order sheet to take home and then you can look over all of the participating businesses and the percentage of their contribution. Once you are in the habit of using it you will wonder why it took you so long to get started. I get upset at myself if I run out and have to pay for something without using SCRIP. That rarely happens any more for me because of my fore planning You may think what is 2 or 3 percent going to help out with, anyway. If you spend \$100 for groceries a week and 3% goes to our SCRIP program, we receive \$3. With \$800 families in our parish and everyone used SCRIP that would be \$2,400 a week, times 52 that's \$124,500 in a year. That is just one small example of food, not to mention gas cards, Amazon, restaurants and possibly large purchases at Mennards, etc. Would you throw away that kind of money on items that you are going to purchase anyway. Well, that's what you are doing. SCRIP has the potential to become a 2nd source income as opposed to a 3rd source income, but we all have to use it to take full advantage of its benefits. Please talk to me about it if you have doubts, concerns, or a lack of understanding of what it actually is. Once you understand, and if you care at all, then, like prayer, you will get into this wonderful habit. So, RUSH over to St. John's School during the week, or stop by the SCRIP table by the staircase to the choir loft in church after any of the weekend Masses to pick up or order your SCRIP and support our parish budget in this simple and easy, no cost to you, crucial way.
