Dear brothers and sisters,

This coming Saturday, January 22, we

I, beg you, dear brothers and sisters, to put aside all the differences, all our selfish motives and support and proclaim the sacredness of every human life from conception to natural death. Let us not compromise with the truths of our faith for any reason. The media and politicians cannot decide what truth is. The Bible clearly says that God is the truth and we have His teachings recorded in the Bible. Therefore, let us put aside our own selfish motives and be influenced by our God's teachings to save the lives of those innocent unborn babies. 


