Are You Praying for the Unborn on the 22nd?



Dear brothers and sisters,

This coming Saturday, January 22, we are observing the 49th anniversary of Roe v. Wade, Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion nationwide. This is my opinion that if all the 204 million Christians in our country be united and stand against the abortion we could have made the Supreme Court to overturn its decision of Roe v. Wade by now.

I, beg you, dear brothers and sisters, to put aside all the differences, all our selfish motives and support and proclaim the sacredness of every human life from conception to natural death. Let us not compromise with the truths of our faith for any reason. The media and politicians cannot decide what truth is. The Bible clearly says that God is the truth and we have His teachings recorded in the Bible. Therefore, let us put aside our own selfish motives and be influenced by our God's teachings to save the lives of those innocent unborn babies. Let us raise our voices in love wherever possible to support the Pro-Life Movement. Have a blessed week! God Bless!

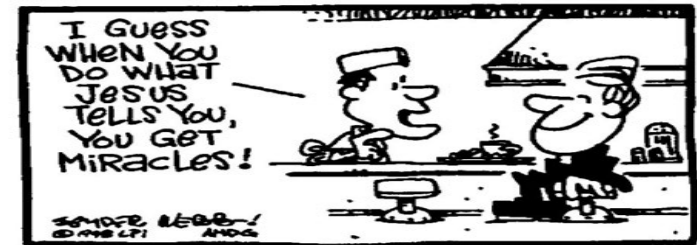
