Why send your kids to Summer Camp-Totus Tuus, Camp Summit or Steubenville Rochester?

If you've been taking your son or daughter to church since they were born, it's easy for them to think of it as just something their parents believe. Most youngsters don't make such a statement until high school or college, but it remains a "family faith" rather than a personal one. Summer camp can be one of the first opportunities for kids to make belief their own—when God exists in daily talks and conversations but no authority forces them to believe. Not every kid will come to such a critical development in their faith, but camp at least gives them the opportunity for it. And if they do so, they'll think back to that summer as one of the most important periods of their life.
