

Christmas Blessings and Gratitude

It takes an enormous amount of effort behind the scenes to bring Christmas to life in our communities. Choir members, faith formation leaders and families, liturgy committees and ministers, priests and all the faithful alike rejoiced to have more normal Christmas celebrations. Our hearts desire to celebrate Jesus Christ as the "reason for the season." Thank you all for helping to make Christmas special!

Christmas Season Feast Days

With Christmas falling on a Saturday, we can enjoy the natural layering of Feast Days in the Christmas Liturgical Season. The Church's liturgical celebrations bring the stories of the Gospels to life for us to once again be a part of as we journey with Christ through this liturgical year. Here are the major feast days and solemnities of the season:

The Nativity of the Lord (Christmas)

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph usually falls on the first Sunday after Christmas and celebrates the sacredness of family life by recognizing their role in the center of salvation history.

Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God on New Year's Day gives us a chance to honor "the first Christian", the one whose *fiat* or "yes" permitted the dwelling for God's incarnation in Christ.

The Epiphany of the Lord is typically the first Sunday of the New Year and celebrates the Word of God (Jesus Christ) revealed to the nations and God's desire to show us his love for us and desire to save us.

The Baptism of the Lord concludes the Christmas Liturgical Season, celebrating Christ revealed to us by the voice of God and the descent of the dove at the waters of the River Jordan.

Br. Amadeus Ordained a Deacon

Deacon Amadeus Mhagama, OSB was ordained to the transitional deaconate by Bishop Donald Kettler in a ceremony at Saint John's Abbey on December 11, 2021. He has been doing a pastoral internship in our parishes and will be preaching at Sunday liturgies now. Deacon Amadeus is a seminarian at Saint John's and hopes to be ordained to the priesthood at his home monastery St. Marus in Hanga, Tanzania (East Africa).


