REFLECTIONS FROM HARVEST OF HOPE

GOD OF THE LIVING By Deacon Jeff Fromm

So here we are nearing the end of the Church Year, only a few weeks away. In today's gospel from Luke, Jesus has entered Jerusalem and is nearing the end of his days on earth. Jesus is questioned by members of the sect of the Sadducees who did not believe in the resurrection of the body. Jesus' response is beautiful. When speaking to Moses, God had identified himself by saying: "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob". God didn't say: 'I used to be' ... but "I am. I still am". So, Jesus' point is that if God is still their God, still their friend, then necessarily they are somehow still alive. Jesus sees all the faithful who have died as somehow still living! Jesus says at the end of our gospel, "God is God not of the dead, but of the living, for to him (God) all are alive." So, I can rightly say that my mother is alive, my dad's alive ... all those who have gone before us in faith are alive. Yes, of course, in a different way, but alive! As far as God is concerned, they are as alive as they ever were. Jesus wants us to believe this as well!

During November, we have the wonderful tradition of praying for the dead, i.e. those who are yet alive in a different way. We do this because we still have a relationship with those who have died in faith. When we have been in a loving relationship with someone on earth, that love, that relationship does not end here on earth. Remember we are in a personal relationship with God who is love. God relates with us as one who loves. We are God's beloved. Nothing can change the reality of God's love for us. Even after his crucifixion, and the disciples' defection and denial, he kept on calling them "brothers" and wishing them "Peace!" Those of us who have lost loved ones realize that their loving presence remains with us often and in many ways. That ongoing loving relationship continues to nourish us while we are here on earth and will continue when we join our loved ones again in heaven.

My parents have been gone for over 20 years, yet I can still feel their presence with me. Their legacy is strong in my life. Often, I find myself asking what they would say about something, how would they feel about something I'm doing...their love is still strong in my life. I think most of you have had that experience of a loved one who has died but is yet alive. I certainly do not worship or adore my parents, but I do pray to them and thank them for all they have given me and continue to inspire me.

Whether on this side of heaven or the other side we are all part of the Communion of Saints, the living Body of Christ. This is what we say in the Apostle's Creed "... l believe in... the communion of saints...the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting."


