Greetings from Ghana

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

Peace! I would like to register my profound gratitude to you for your prayers and support.

This is to inform you that by God's Grace I have arrived safely in Accra. Thanks to Bob and Susan Downey who took me to the Des Moines airport and waited until I cleared security. Many thanks to all those who attempted to take me to the airport as well. This kind gesture bespeaks of your love and care.

Accra is currently warm with temperatures ranging from 70-90. I am making arrangements to send you some warm weather and sunshine to brighten your day and keep you warm from the Des Moines cold weather. Please check your phone for warm weather alert.

My family is doing fine. The members extend their greetings and appreciation to you. My mom asked if I will be going back. I told her to pray for snow in Ghana so that I remain. She has started praying but Ghana has Never had snow before.

It's nice visiting with old friends and church members. In as much as they would like to see me around, I am also being careful of the virus.

I have missed my church family already. My little angels at the school have been greatly missed. I am praying for you as you do for me.

Long road to Ghana

It is possible many of you are eager to know my journey from lowa to Accra-Ghana.

When I got up in the morning of January 9th, one thing that was certain was to prepare my mind that wearing my shoe will take me to the evening of Monday, January 10th. After my morning prayer, I set out to church. Celebrating Mass before traveling has become part of my spirituality.

Due to the short window of time to check in, I left immediately before some could trace my footprint. Everything went well from Des Moines to Atlanta. I had about 4hrs layover, which was an opportunity to pray and touch base with others.

The journey continued to JFK in New York. Remember during this time I have to wear my mask throughout.

I had another layover at New York until the flight departed at 11:55pm. As a way of praising myself for wearing my shoes all day along I gave myself a treat. Wow ooo!

The journey from Sunday morning in Iowa finally came to an end on Monday late afternoon when we got off the plane. Hurray!!! Thanks be to God for his traveling mercies.

The pandemic with its precautionary shades of color was another huddle to cross.

Ghana requires all persons entering the country to take another covid test at the airport. Thus, I went through another test and was cleared to go home.

My house from the airport is just about 25mins drive depending on the traffic flow.

So far everything went well as planned. I am indebted to your prayers.

During this vacation, I will take a personal retreat. Then, I will visit the beaches even though I am not good at swimming. I will also drive around the cities to catch up with developments and changes.

Hopefully, I will depart Ghana on February 24th and arrive in JFK at 5:10am the next day. I should finally get home around 6:30pm.

This is just a little note of humor telling you I have arrived safely.

The second reading for this weekend is a call for us to be involved in various ministries. God has given us what it takes to minister in various ways. Currently, we are in need of sacristans to help in setting up for Mass. A close look at ministers will reveal that the same people are putting their hands in every pie. Let us get involved by encouraging others, too. The youth and young adults are encouraged to volunteer as well.

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

**GROW**: It was several years ago now, but the scene is still vivid in my mind. My son stood confidently in front of the altar as the music rose in a crescendo and his bride stepped into sight. The love and joy he felt trickled down his cheek as she walked down the aisle. He broke into a smile as she joined him, and proudly took her hand to promise to become one with her forever. Isaiah writes: "As a bridegroom rejoices in his bride so shall your God rejoice in you." Isaiah was talking about the nation of Israel, but God loves and rejoices in each of his children and wants us to know the joy of being loved by him. He generously shares his gifts with us, "different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit," St. Paul explains to the Corinthians. *All* spiritual gifts come from God, and *all* are important and necessary: "To each individual, the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." God's gifts are distributed uniquely to each person to use in our own unique way to "announce his salvation, day after day," and invite others to discover the joy of his great love.

#### GO EVANGELIZE | PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

**GO**: You are a masterpiece! This message was conveyed at the camp our diocese held each year to help teens recognize that they are God's beloved sons and daughters, called and gifted by the Holy Spirit to be missionary disciples. Discerning what our gifts are and how to use them can be challenging. The Gospel about the wedding at Cana offers an interesting guide. Mary tells the waiters, "Do whatever he tells you." By reserving time for listening and not speaking during prayer, we can hear what Jesus is "telling" us. Jesus then says to the waiters, "Fill the jars with water." We can "fill our jars" with the knowledge of how to live as disciples by reflecting on Scripture. Finally, Jesus tells the waiters, "Draw some out." We can "draw" on his love for strength and courage when we need it, but more importantly, we are called to "draw some out" to share with others. In sharing the "good wine," the Good News of Jesus Christ, others will begin to believe in him, too.

**PRAYER**: As the new year gets under way, devote time to discerning the unique spiritual gifts, or charisms, you have been given. Make time for silent prayer and reflecting on Scripture each day.


