

Reflections from Fr. Peter Kieffer



When I was in college, one of my professors had a saying that went like this:

Good, better, best.

Never let it rest.

Until the good becomes better, and the better becomes the best.

Why?

Because the human mind and the human heart were made for the best.

And, they will never truly be at rest, until they have the best.

So...

Hitch your wagon to a star.

In other words, aim high.

Because, if you aim low, you may just end up below the below.

The theme of this poem is to seek out the best. The best, that we only will find in God and in being who God creates us to be. Searching for the better and the best requires a certain amount of comparison on our part. In requires us to make use of good comparison and to avoid bad comparison.

Good comparison makes us better and is from God. In Matthew 5:48 Jesus says, "Be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect." Jesus knows that we will never be perfect. Only God is perfect. Yet, Jesus calls us to strive for the best and to be our best. This kind of comparison leads us to seek out what is true and good. When we compare in this way, we come to appreciate reality. We see ourselves as who we are, and we flourish. It makes us grateful and appreciative of the gifts that God has given to us, and it makes us aware of the things that need to change in ourselves.

Bad comparison, on the other hand, makes us worse and is from the devil. Bad comparison is debilitating and can keep us from being ourselves. It prevents us from being who God makes us to be. Rather than focus on the reality of who we are (for better or for worse), comparison makes us focus on something imaginary or fake, that may never actually come to pass. It turns us in on ourselves, and it causes us to compare ourselves to others about unimportant things. It makes us ungrateful, and it distracts us from overcoming the bad habits and vices that we have.

What kinds of comparisons do you make? Are you someone who makes good comparisons, or are you one who falls into bad comparisons?

How could you improve? What things should you spend less time focusing on? What things should you spend more time focusing on?

Good, better, best. Never let it rest.

Until the good becomes better, and the better becomes the best.

St. Raymond of Peñafort "Evening of Intercession"



News from Peru - Being the Anchor of Hope!



A common petition at daily Mass of the children and families is, "We pray for all of the people who help us here at Casa so that we can live the life we have and be safe." This reality is significant to us during these days of the pandemic. Peru is full of unrest and division as the country decides its future president and hospitals continue to fill. Amid the instability and uncertainty, providing a safe home where the children and staff can grow is more important than ever. Your support helps us offer the anchor of stability and hope for our 72 children, teachers, staff, and families who call Casa their home.

Virtual classes occupy most of our daily life here at Casa, where we put to good use every tablet, phone, and computer donated. Mass, Holy Hour, meals, sports, and music fill our days. On the weekends, the children take turns visiting with members of their biological families who visit, all the while maintaining social distance. The consolation for the visiting family members is that they know the children are safe, cared for, and solidly prepared for a promising future.

What is it that our children need most of all at this time? They need to know that there are people who care for them during all the chaos and that we will fight for them and give them the tools to face life with hope and courage. Our hope is not to survive the pandemic; we are here to learn how to thrive through the pandemic. The children are learning this kind of hope and perseverance to stay strong. Father Joe Walijewski always taught the children to breathe with both lungs of family and faith if they are to have a future.

Soon we will have a new Development Director to take over for Sarah Sceery, who will always be with us as a promoter of Casa. I sincerely appreciate her dedication to the Cause of Father Joe Walijewski and Casa Hogar. We ask for your patience during this time of transition and hope to introduce a new person soon.

<u>We are ever grateful for your support</u>. It means so much at any time and **even more during these difficult times**. Please know that we are praying for you, and May the Lord bless you and your families.


