





A Note from Fr. Derek Sakowski



During Easter week, Jon Jones notified me that he and his family would be moving back to Tennessee after 21 months of living in Altoona, during which time he served as Director of Pastoral Ministry for St. Mary and St. Raymond parishes.

I am grateful both to Jon and to Carrie and their five children for pouring their hearts into our communities. During two difficult years of Pandemic, Jon devoted over 3,000 hours to building up small groups, Hispanic Ministry, communication, pastoral outreach to the sick and homebound (over 100 people in need in a few dozen locations!), receptionists in the parish office, leadership on the pastoral councils, and much more.

Carrie and their five children willingly volunteered in parish life - in music ministry, Elizabeth ministry, confessional ministry, and altar serving. They were often present for multiple masses on a weekend as they sought to get to know all the people attending all five of the Masses.

So my heart is filled with both gratitude and sadness. It will be a joy to celebrate with their daughter Maria as she makes her First Holy Communion in May.

This was a very challenging personal decision for them, and of course moving is never easy. Please keep them in your prayers during their transition.

Now that the worst of the pandemic appears to have passed - and with all the heartache that so many of us have experienced - there is more a need for small group fellowship than ever. I dream of the day when any given parish member (longtime or brand new) will easily find a group in which he/she can experience connection, understanding, comfort, encouragement, listening, and growth in love of God and neighbor. There are also dozens of Spanish-speaking families (in both parishes) that are needing our pastoral care. So please pray for me and the parishes as we look to figure out next steps in hiring staff.

Be assured of my prayers for each of you and gratitude to each of you. Happy Easter!

Quinceañera Retreat

St. Mary's will be having the first Retreat for Quinceañeras on Friday May 13, 2022. We ask for prayers from our parishioners for these young ladies participating in this retreat.

The quinceañera is a traditional celebration of life and gratitude to God on the occasion of the fifteenth birthday of a young Hispanic woman. The ritual emphasizes her passage from childhood to adulthood. The family usually requests a Mass or a blessing to be held in the Church. The retreat will consist of talks, activities and prayer, together with the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance. The focus on the positive contribution of women in society as well as their becoming active participants in the life of the parish.

Together, with other families, spend an hour in prayer with our Lord on the second Friday of the month. Children of all ages are encouraged to participate in adoration, being as loud and active in their prayer as necessary. Come as you are - even those in pajamas!
