

"A Message from Fr. Charlie Friebohle

Soon we will be entering into the month of October. This is a very special month for us because it is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. Not only is Our Lady of the Rosary the patroness of the Cathedral, but she is also the patroness of the Diocese. The Rosary is a very beautiful prayer that I hope you will come to a deeper appreciation of during this upcoming month.

The Rosary is very powerful. One tradition of its origin is that Mary gave it to St. Dominic in a vision to pray as an aide to fight against the heresy he was preaching against. After he was successful, saints have been promoting it as one of the most powerful prayers outside of the Sacraments. As Padre Pio reminds us, "The Rosary is the weapon of our times," and Our Lady of Fatima echoed this saying, "Pray the Rosary every day, to obtain peace for the world."

One of the most famous examples of the power of the Rosary actually has a connection to us. In 1571 the Ottoman Empire was trying to conquer Christian countries of Europe. Knowing that the Holy League was outmatched, Pope Pius V asked all the faithful to pray the Rosary and to go to Eucharistic Adoration. With all the faithful praying the Rosary, the winds miraculously changed, and the Holy League was able to come out victorious. In honor of this, Pope Pius V named the date of the battle, October 7, as the Feast of Our Lady of Victory which would later be renamed Our Lady of the Rosary.

Let us take up this same call and start praying the Rosary every day, and making it to Eucharistic Adoration when we can. We can all see the turmoil that the world is in today, and how much it needs our prayers. Let us use this powerful tool to help transform the world, and not be surprised about the miracles that Mary will obtain for us.

If you do not know how to the pray the Rosary there are many tools out there to help. Most churches have pamphlets available, the Cathedral YouTube page has a recording of the school children praying the Rosary, and there are books like Secret of the Rosary by St. Louis de Montfort that can help us see the true beauty of this devotion. Faith Formation Today's Gospel contains a strong message for those who share the responsibility of fostering faith. It is indeed an awesome responsibility. Today's Gospel reminds us that faith is a lifelong journey toward God. We don't always get it all or even get it right. But we pray for the grace to acknowledge and build upon even the smallest signs of faith, in ourselves and in others

We know that during our lifetimes we change in many ways. We mature physically and emotionally. During our lifetime our faith also changes and, hopefully, matures. But this development isn't as easily recognized as our physical maturity or growing independence.

There are plenty of obstacles that might prevent the

There are plenty of obstacles that might prevent the growth of our faith. There may be times in our lives when we feel like we have little faith or that our faith is weak and insecure. Jesus will not judge us for this. In this Gospel we find encouragement for these times of doubt. If we continue to pray and act on our faith during these times, Jesus will help our faith grow stronger. As a family, observe that there are things in our lives that nurture our faith and things that can hinder it. Talk about some of the things that nurture our faith healthy family relationships, healthy friendships, good literature, and so on. Name some of the things that might be an obstacle to faith—unhealthy relationships, scandals, and so on. Observe that Jesus teaches us in today's Gospel that we are to do everything we can to help one another have faith in Jesus and do all that we can to avoid creating obstacles that might hinder another person's faith.

Let us pray that we are not contributing to the obstacles that might hinder another person's faith in Jesus, but let us appreciate the good deeds of others, who are working, like us, to serve the Kingdom of God.
